

Planetary Forecast for November 6-12, 2006

Apologies for the much abbreviated forecast. It's deadline time!

This week...Monday, November 6th brings Taurus Moon squaring with Saturn (in Leo) at 2:19 a.m. EST. The pasture-loving bull rebelling against boundaries? Consider the reasons that could be. At 3:30 Moon then forms a quincunx with Pluto (in Sagittarius) and opposes Jupiter (in Scorpio) at 5:17. Someone is determined to cut corners, play dirty, fight for keeps in this next twenty-four hours. Smell an election coming on? You bet. While "the best men/women" are unlikely to win (because they aren't on the ballots) if we don't take advantage of our right to vote, don't whine on Wednesday when the talking heads on TV continue to tell you what to think. At 11:45 Moon sprints into Gemini and the afternoon will crank into high gear, but expect a great deal of contradiction. The Twins' influence is known to provide whiplash. Venus (in Scorpio) then squares with Neptune (in Pisces) at 7:23 p.m. EST refusing to sugarcoat the bad news. Watch for a pending stock correction and do your Christmas shopping early. After you pay property taxes, of course. Otherwise, watch while traveling, the roads should be slick and full of preoccupied people.

Tuesday, the 7th aka Election Day will have a 4:23 a.m. EST quincunx between Gemini Moon and Mars (in Scorpio) meaning the chatter and vitriol is ratcheting up several degrees—and don't expect things to be quiet overseas as the radicals want to help with the upheaval. At 5:55, Moon then squares with Uranus (in Pisces) rejecting and squashing this behavior. By 11:51 the "haves" will be at the polling booths as Mercury conjuncts with Venus (in Scorpio), and by 1:11 p.m. EST Moon will quincunx with Scorpio Sun like a bantamweight boxer. At 4:22 Moon trines with Neptune (in Aquarius) followed by a 5:19 quincunx with Mercury (in Scorpio). In the end at 6:24 Moon forms a quincunx with Venus and while we may be hearing words of appreciation and love, watch that wallet. Either way, the handwriting is on the wall and these are not easy times.

Wednesday the 8th at 3:24 a.m. EST Mercury (in Scorpio) squares with Neptune (in Aquarius) followed by Saturn sextiling with Gemini Moon at 4:55. By dawn watch for Moon to oppose Pluto (in Sagittarius) and talkers thumbing their nose at history and fate. When 8:42 and Jupiter advances into a quincunx with Moon not all will be cheering. Mars will trine with Uranus and that's always a sign of damage and trouble. Whether that's overseas or locally, only time will tell. Moon enters sensitive Cancer at 2:46. That's it until 4:30 p.m. when Scorpio Sun conjuncts with Mercury (in Scorpio). Use the time for creative projects, and dine with a dear one. Just avoid the big decisions and big projects for later this month.

Thursday the 9th Scorpio Sun squares with Neptune (in Aquarius) at 9:59 a.m. EST. This is the theme for the week repeated over and over—it's time to start behaving like adults. Within eight minutes Cancer Moon trines with Uranus (in Pisces), so watch for empathetic conversations and olive branches offered—a surprise to some. The next trine occurs between Moon and Mars (in Scorpio) at 11:22 and that seriously energetic Water energy could be strong tears or a weather event, but also terrific brainstorming. Then more chatter/communication occurs as Moon trines with Mercury (in Scorpio) at 5:34 p.m. EST followed by a 9:26 Moon Neptune (in Aquarius) quincunx. Turn off the TV and pick up a good book because there's nothing but denial spewing on the airwaves. While you're at it, check electrical wires and make sure your computer virus protection is up to date. Mercury is in particularly shaky ground here.

Friday, the 10th, we get a break on the excess of activity and need to deal with only three aspects and a Moon switch. First at 5:18 a.m. Cancer Moon trines with Venus (in Scorpio) and marks a great time for relationships we most care about and making wise purchases. At 12:31 p.m. EST, however, watch for a Moon Pluto (in Sagittarius) quincunx. Okay, if it IS broken, toss/end it. Otherwise, take a serious look at what is in the soul and where you

want to take your life. At 3:58 Moon trines with Jupiter (in Scorpio)—a good sign that you're on the right track. Finally Moon enters Leo at 9:34. We're cranking up the enthusiasm level...now where to direct it?

Saturday the 11th is Veterans Day—put out a flag and thank someone who has served. It's another modest day activity-wise, but involves the big players. At 10:18 a.m. EST, Mercury (in Scorpio) conjuncts with Mars (in Scorpio) and that's the tone for the day—a great deal of passionate talk or big messages sent. How that plays around the world should be interesting. With this Water energy surplus, a weather event could occur at any time, as well. That's it until 6:23 p.m. EST when Leo Moon forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces), followed three hours later by a Moon-Mercury square and ninety minutes after that a Moon-Mars square. Watch for old arguments to resurface.

Sunday the 12th, Leo Moon continues being cranky and opposes Neptune (in Aquarius) at 6:37 a.m. EST. Wish Leo would make up his mind and decide if he believes the glass is half full or is it only pink glasses that are half full? At 12:45 p.m. EST Moon then squares with Scorpio Sun; now there's not a great chunk of common ground there, but there's always the concept of compromise. Another square strikes at 7:19 between Venus (in Scorpio) and Saturn (in Leo) pointing clearly to a tense day as few listen. The conjunction between Moon and Saturn two hours later speaks to willfulness. Fine if you can foot the bill, but Venus squares with Moon in minutes and wants no part of that behavior. Ignore that message if you will, but Pluto enters the scene by 10:51 to trine with Moon. Pluto is in not-always-reliable Sagittarius. Be careful who loan your wallet and heart to.
