

## Planetary Forecast for July 30-August 4, 2007

*In review...* Monday's intense Water energy did produce lots of rain, but nowhere as much as in Great Britain where they're experiencing the worst flooding in sixty years. As warned, the danger in taking risks proved out in the multiple plane crashes during the week: a Cessna in N.J. a Switzerland crash where a veteran American pilot went into an apartment building and playground, two news helicopters colliding in Arizona while following a police chase, two planes in a Wisconsin air show, and a biplane in Dayton, Ohio air show. In addition Polish pilgrims in France suffered a fatal bus crash with 26 killed and almost two dozen injured. Tuesday's problem with Scorpio Moon and Saturn made sense when 29,000 sex offenders were removed from the internet site MySpace.com--that's four times the number MySpace claimed were on there. The earthquake and volcanic concerns for the week were illustrated by Hawaii's famous Kilauea spewed lava for the first time in sixteen years. There was also a tremendous explosion at a Dallas welding tank refilling plant. Acetylene tanks were blown along the Trinity River, bridges and onto interstates. In addition mudslides occurred in Utah closing an interstate after devastating fires devoured the vegetation that would protect the earth from monsoon rains. Finally, a 6.9 earthquake in Indonesia triggered tsunami concerns. Sorry to be redundant, but with all of the retrogrades, it's apparent that poor reasoning and accidents are even more likely to continue happening. Please heed the old adage, "Stop, look, and listen."

*This week...* Monday, July 30<sup>th</sup> will begin with the 2:58 a.m. EDT, Aquarius Moon sextile with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) with an opportunity for fast movement on projects and other ideas thanks to the push from Air and Fire energy--but avoid excess. There's a long lull--until 4:00 p.m. EDT-- when Mercury (in Cancer) forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius) bringing an opportunity for afternoon thunderstorms, but also for pushing an unwelcome or badly inspired idea. There's yet another six hour lull when at 10:08 Moon conjuncts with Neptune. Then at 11:01 Moon forms a quincunx with Mercury. It would be a good idea not to dive headfirst into a conversation or conflict unless you want to end up with the responsibility of cleaning up the results.

*Tuesday*, the 31<sup>st</sup> starts with a 5:55 a.m. EDT square between Aquarius Moon and Mars (in Taurus). Ouch. Some won't have heeded Monday's warning. At 6:28, Moon then opposes Saturn (in Leo) a serious breach with costly or even deadly results because the 7:55 sextile between Moon and Pluto (in Sagittarius) warns that the body toll or damage cost could be high. Moon shifts into Pisces at 1:40 p.m. EDT, which is better for psychic help, and wisdom from the evolved, but for the underdeveloped, watch for selfishness. There's a four-plus hour period of adjustment, then at 6:09, Moon opposes Venus (in Virgo) which could bode new arguments from the self-serving. Why? Because at 7:59 Mars (in Taurus) squares with Saturn (in Leo) and that's a strong indication that some won't take "no," or "don't do it" for an answer.

*Wednesday*, August 1<sup>st</sup> and Pisces Moon forms a quincunx with Leo Sun at 4:39 a.m. EDT as Moon tries to tone down Sun's tenacity for excess. By 6:45 Moon then squares with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) another dousing on Fire energy and an appeal for thrift and caution. At 8:35 p.m. EDT, Moon conjuncts with Uranus (also in Pisces) bringing double Water energy and perhaps heavier than usual rainfall--or tears of frustration or helplessness. Not surprisingly, at 11:00 we close the day with a Mars (in Taurus) quincunx with Pluto (in Sagittarius) and aside from concerns for environmental issues (fire, earthquake, or volcanic activity) keep an eye out for someone ready to snap or operating machinery when angry or being reckless.

*Thursday* the 2<sup>nd</sup> brings seven aspects and Moon's shift--a busy day and one with a

potential for vast pendulum-swing effects on the emotions and psyche. Beginning at 9:48 a.m. EDT, Pisces Moon trines with Mercury (in Cancer) bringing double Water energy and a strong potential for heavy rainfall where Low Pressure Systems have stalled, and eloquence and (hopefully) wisdom for those wanting to articulate their message. At 10:05, Moon then forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Leo) an unusual and forceful breaking of tradition and rules to achieve a goal. At 11:00 Moon then squares with Pluto (in Sagittarius), which will be interesting to see played out in the news. At 11:12 Leo Sun then trines with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) bringing double Fire energy, and while that's wholehearted enthusiasm and an open-wallet charge toward success, whether that's good news or bad news is going to depend on the "who" and "what" involved. Also watch for environmental trouble and the potential for calamity and violence. By 11:36 Pisces Moon then sextiles with Mars (in Taurus). Moon enters Aries at 4:43 p.m. EDT, another clue that it'll be a feisty and loud day. Then at 6:54, Mercury (in Cancer) forms a quincunx with Pluto (in Sagittarius) and we could see a sharp verbal rebuke, saber rattling, or ugly domestic trouble. We close with the 8:53 Aries Moon quincunx with Venus (in Virgo). Little chance for tender romance tonight; it's all about passion and ego--and I fear it will be conducted by those seeking blood.

*Friday*, the 3<sup>rd</sup> will have minimal activity--no surprise after active Thursday. At 5:53 a.m. EDT, Mercury (in Cancer) sextiles with Mars (in Taurus) and that's legislative and investigative momentum pushing forward to put out fires and to regain stability. At 9:29 Aries Moon trines with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) bringing double Fire energy. There's less opportunity for heavy rainfall, but a strong opportunity to make progress on projects and chores. But don't discount secondary attacks or retaliation for earlier activity. At 11:07 Moon trines with Leo Sun ; a youthful party atmosphere may seem odd, even inappropriate at this time, but our children need their vacation/play time. As for the rest, history shows a repeated pattern for how myopia and denial are characterized by those who feel fighting the rolling snowball is someone else's problem.

*Saturday* the 4<sup>th</sup> at 3:55 a.m. EDT, Aries Moon sextiles with Neptune (in Aquarius) bringing more Fire-Air energy and bright ideas--hopefully, copasetic ones. At 1:06 p.m. EDT, Moon then trines with Saturn (in Leo) bringing double Fire energy and fast movement and excitement; but also watch for arson and environmental trouble. By 1:15 Mercury enters Leo bringing speedy and not always edited dialogue. At 1:31 Aries Moon trines with Pluto (in Sagittarius). *Sunday*, the 5<sup>th</sup> and Taurus Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) at 12:01 p.m. Moon then squares with Leo Sun at 5:19. This is a recovery and planning day. It takes a great effort to push Taurean buttons to commit violence and Monday's aspects will be numerous and tangible. Use today to heal, to promote goodwill, and otherwise stabilize the home whether that's psychologically or literally.

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
