

## Planetary Forecast December 21-27, 2009

*In review...*on Monday, we were talking about things being "wet, cold, and emotional" and by Saturday that's still the case. The largest storm system in three decades that has shut down the East Coast and claimed at least five lives, fulfills the wet and cold momentum, and the emotional aspects were exhibited by the following: on Monday a San Clemente, Ca. family was founded murdered in their gated community after a court dispute; in the same state on Tuesday a knife-yielding woman was shot and killed in a school by police; Wednesday, Cincinnati Bengals receiver Chris Henry died from head trauma after he jumped or fell from a pickup truck driven by his fiancée, and a top Mexican drug lord was killed; Thursday, a New York City family was found murdered in their apartment and the murderer (a former prison acquaintance) falls to his death. As for the concerns for arson--yes, someone in North Carolina showed the worst Christmas spirit by vandalizing a family's home, stealing their presents, taking clothes from drawers, and then setting the house on fire. Also there was the Ohio City Hall fire on Monday, which is now known to have been started by a Molotov cocktail. As for Pluto's presence (and don't forget the eclipses are still involved with all of this) who among the famous did we lose so far? Oral Roberts (along with Chris Henry). The concern for earthquakes and volcanic activity bore results when a volcano in the Philippines erupted again and in Taiwan there has been a 6.4 quake and a 6.0 in the East African nation of Malawi.

*This week...*Monday, December 21st will be ultra busy starting with Venus (in Sagittarius) in sextile with Neptune (in Aquarius) at 12:24 a.m. EST. So we start the week carrying on the weekend song-and-dance from Washington. For those who are simply interested in the holidays and/or romance, it's a perfect atmosphere for either or both. At 3:33, Aquarius Moon conjuncts with Chiron (in Aquarius). This is double Air energy, so creativity in the backrooms in Washington D.C. is rampant. In seventeen minutes that's followed by Jupiter (also in Aquarius) conjuncting with Neptune (again in Aquarius). Someone bought the program. The 7:06, Aquarius Moon conjunction with Neptune, and in three minutes, Moon conjunction with Jupiter begs the question again...what new backroom shenanigans are going on inside our government--or with the Copenhagen Climate Summit? At 7:33, Mercury (in Capricorn) will quincunx with Mars (in Leo). The message that strong-arming is in progress didn't need a loudspeaker, so this could also be news of some volcanic or earthquake activity that creates travel or residential havoc. At 7:54, Moon then sextiles with Venus. If this sounds like someone running back and forth between bedroom suites to "satisfy" many mistresses, you're close to being on target. Politics-wise, this should appall and outrage the electorate. We get a brief respite until the 12:47 p.m. EST, Sun enters Capricorn. At 6:42, Moon then enters Pisces. At 7:16, Pisces Moon then sextiles with Capricorn Sun. Earth and Water are in harmony, and that should be great for meetings, but be careful where heavy snows exist. Warm ups could mean avalanche conditions and in other areas flooding threats. If there is a quake, a tsunami is not out of the question, despite this harmonious atmosphere. Why do I suggest the difficulties? Because we'll

end with the 7:42, Moon square with Ceres (in Sagittarius). With Fire and Water clashing, this puts the earth and women/their families in jeopardy.

*Tuesday* the 22nd is limited to only two aspects, the 12:42 a.m. EST, Pisces Moon sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn) and the 3:13, Moon quincunx with Saturn (in Libra). A sextile should bring good news, but not necessarily when Pluto is involved. The fact that we are limited today by two aspects and that the other is low/borders/lessons-related Saturn tells me that we could lose some famous people or many people due to addictions, water/ice-related catastrophies or outright mean-spirited attacks. Otherwise, opportunities to recreate onself are present.

*Wednesday* the 23rd will be another limited activity day with only the 10:13 a.m. EST, Pisces Moon quincunx with Mars (in Leo). (Remember Mars is in retrograde.) The 1:06 p.m. EST, Moon sextile with Mercury (in Capricorn). And the 4:43, Moon conjunction with Uranus (in Pisces). Watch for people with tempers--especially with travel being a challenge due to weather conditions and the holiday stresses. Expect the unexpected, but also use this opportunity to brainstorm with people who bring out your best ideas.

*Thursday*, the 24th and Christmas Eve brings increased concerns beginning with the 3:09 a.m. EST, Pisces Moon square with Venus (in Sagittarius). At 6:40, Moon then shifts into Aries. At 9:41, Aries Moon trines with Ceres (in Sagittarius). At 12:32 p.m. EST, Capricorn Sun conjuncts with Pluto (also in Capricorn). In four minutes, Moon then squares with Sun. (First Quarter Moon) At the same time, Moon squares with Pluto. By 3:01, Moon opposes Saturn (in Libra). If the health care bill is still being pushed through the senate, the day could be a bloodbath and bad blood will live for years. There's no doubt that the law and the constitution are being trampled by progressives. It would be a good idea for everyone to back off and readdress things in January. For the poor souls just trying to get the family together for Christmas, travel with extra care, do not allow yourself to get preoccupied when operating machinery and watch where you're stepping.

*Friday*, the 25th and Christmas Day begins with Venus shifting into Capricorn at 1:17 p.m. EST. At 6:58, Capricorn Sun squares with Saturn (in Libra). At 8:00 p.m. EST, Moon trines with Mars (in Leo). This may sound like a "Bah-humbug" day, but it's going to be better if we remember that with Mercury going retrograde and holiday pressures high, and the economy difficult, we could do ourselves more good by putting a favorite CD on and saying a prayer for all those who do with much less, and for those serving to protect what we have.

*Saturday*, the 26th starts with the 12:16 a.m. EST, Aries Moon square with Mercury (in Capricorn). At 2:11, Moon sextiles with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 5:11, Moon sextiles with Neptune (again in Aquarius). at 6:44, Moon sextiles with Jupiter (also in Aquarius). Now prepare for Mercury to go retrograde in Capricorn at 9:38. That's it until Moon moves into Taurus at 3:26 p.m. EST. At 6:12, Taurus Moon trines with Venus (in Capricorn). At 8:05, Moon forms a quincunx with Ceres (in Sagittarius). At 9:08, Moon trines with Pluto (in Capricorn). At 11:23, Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Libra).

With Mars in retrograde already, Aries is missing his planet and getting hot under the collar. We could see the resumption of certain kinds of attacks and problems with communications in all other venues/areas. Computer glitches and meltdowns, cell phone crises, etc. are likely as new hackers emerge--especially those wanting to make 2010 come in with a bang. People in problematic domestic situations should continue to take precautions. ANYONE traveling should take a deep breath and expect delays or cancel trips altogether. We're looking at a Full Moon, Lunar Eclipse, and Moon will be in watery, testy Cancer for New Years. It's entirely likely that where Low Pressure prevails another storm is going to cause travel grief.

*Sunday, 27th* and at 1:40 a.m. EST, Taurus Moon will trine with Capricorn Sun. This is a double Earth energy day and there could be environmental issues, either larger than average earthquakes, or people balking at relationships unraveling, etc. For most a feeling of finding stability will be welcome. Others will be making a resolution to spend less in the coming year. Be aware that come Monday there are plenty of squares and two visits by Pluto to add to the "endings" of some relationships/lives.
