

## Planetary Forecast February 1-7, 2010

*In review..sadly my warning for Air-Water clashing and feeling a momentum for accidents came true off the coast of Lebanon where an Ethiopian 737 carrying 90 went down into the Mediterranean during bad weather. The Gemini Moon's deteriorating ability to communicate was in force when the news surfaced that ice-skating champion Nancy Kerrigan's father died after/during an argument with her brother. As for my Tuesday hunch that Uranus in this mix would trigger some news of a particularly strong/bold suicide type of attack, in New Jersey, a Virginia resident was arrested after acting "suspicious." Authorities discovered he was in possession of rifles (including a Bushmaster), grenade launcher, night vision equipment, and he also had maps of Camp Drum in New York. It looks like we narrowly escaped another Fort Hood-type of incident. Wednesday's warning that we'll hear more from those who want to create even a bigger mess with the economy and government--and the State of the Union Address was all that. Friday's increased tension brought the news that a Utah pre-school employee was mortally wounded in the school's parking lot, (shot by her ex-mother-in-law) and a pregnant New Jersey woman, days away from giving birth, has vanished.*

*This week...the continued difficulty in getting things accomplished and to sustain harmony drags on. Deep-breathing exercises and using the hard-earned lessons brought on by our eclipses and the Saturn and Mars period of retrograde could be the difference between finding balance or a middle ground instead of watching conditions plunge into total catastrophe.*

*Monday, February 1st begins a bit later than usual, but remember we had a double dose of Pluto to get through Sunday night, which could explain much. We start with the 4:06 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon plays troubleshooter in a quincunx with Aquarius Sun. That's Moon trying to help us bring projects and plans to fruition. There's a lull, then the 10:51 Moon square with Ceres (in Sagittarius). That's a hard clash between Earth and Fire energy and bodes ill for women and children, including those with difficult domestic situations. We could also be looking at particularly strong volcanic or earthquake activity again, an accident, or costly case of arson. This is followed at 12:43 p.m. EST by Moon's quincunx with Venus (in Aquarius) and at 2:12, Moon's trine with Mercury (in Capricorn). Moon is determined with its message, but may be forcing funding or a relationship a certain way for ulterior motives. We end with the 11:17, Moon opposition to Neptune (in Pisces) indicating a refusal to paint a pretty picture of things, which is usually a good thing.*

*Tuesday the 2nd and Groundhog Day...begins earlier with the 12:48 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon quincunx with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 1:36, Moon then forms a quincunx with Neptune (also in Aquarius). Some are trying to get their agenda through a stalemate. It doesn't look too effective. At 8:42, Moon enters Libra, which is helpful for tact and finding the positive somewhere--but do avoid excessive spending and think long-term and contingencies. At 2:40 p.m. EST, Libra Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Pisces). This Air and Water clash could mean a new Low Pressure system gearing up to bring more precipitation. In an hour (and eight minutes), Moon then conjuncts with*

Saturn (also in Libra). Although it might be a little late, Moon may have decided against a move/expenditure. It's not a bad idea to err on the side of caution. At 4:01, Moon then squares with Pluto (in Capricorn). Avoid battles where you can--the determined are not listening, and think of your health. Not everyone will get out of today alive. Also be aware that moves and relationship changes *are* in the works for some. While they may not lift your heart and mind at first, try to see the potential for opportunity--and an escape from what is draining you. At 10:09, we end with Moon in sextile with Mars (in Leo). Use this energy for work/projects that have been resisting you, and for getting the exercise and chores you've been resisting. Do be careful not to show too much bravado and make a tense matter worse.

*Wednesday* the 3rd starts with the 9:14 a.m. EST, Libra Moon trine with Aquarius Sun bringing ideas and innovation. That's double Air energy, so expect spring-like wind conditions and ideas/chatter to be ramping up. There's a lull until the 1:52 p.m. EST, Moon sextile with Ceres (in Sagittarius), then another lull before the 7:30 p.m. EST, Moon trine with Venus (also in Aquarius). Watch for lots of (so-called) expert advice about how you should spend your money or how policy/relationships should go. Things may belly up when at 9:05, Moon squares with Mercury (in Capricorn). Communications are poor, or are received with strong rejection. Resist a standoff if possible, since conditions may not seem that they can get worse, but they can. I'm not saying throw in the towel, but buy time where you can.

*Thursday*, the 4th and we start early with the 2:08 a.m. EST, Libra Moon quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). If this is inspiration or innovation for a project/work idea, then this could be a good night for burning the midnight oil. But it could also bring tough weather conditions and unwelcome surprises where Low Pressure advances. Then, too, there is the concern for sneak attacks, since following at 3:43, Moon trines with Chiron (in Aquarius), then the 4:27, Moon-Neptune (also in Aquarius) trine. Don't be fooled by those putting a positive spin on things. Whatever is "up" isn't beneficial in any way, shape, or form. There's a considerable lull until Moon shifts into Scorpio at 11:56. That seems to be an analysis-reconnoiter break, which feels like that may bring an opportunity to get some things accomplished if we stay disciplined. But abrupt actions/decisions aren't wise right now. At 7:15 p.m. EST, Scorpio Moon trines with Jupiter (in Pisces) for good luck and benevolence. But remain careful if you're traveling--that's double Water energy. This trine should help with intuition and psychic insight, and also with dreams, but downpours and other precipitation amounts could be on the increase. In 7:54, Moon then sextiles with its own planet Pluto (in Capricorn). This Water-Earth energy could mean accidents and environmental dilemmas. It could also be a precursor for another "above the norm" attack, since early on Friday there's a hard clash with fiery Mars.

*Friday*, the 5th begins with the 12:55 a.m. EST, Scorpio Moon square with Mars (in Leo). Someone is feeling cocky and/or do-or-die bold and aside from the safety concerns, we could be looking at a press release as some in Washington try to slip unpleasant revelations or shady moves into the news cycle to get lost amid the Super Bowl spectacle. Or we could be looking at another attack environment. There's a 3:14, Jupiter (in Pisces) quincunx with Saturn (in Libra) to add to the concern. Order is being

compromised and law manipulated. In the next 24-48 hours some are really playing a costly hand. The 6:48 p.m. EST, Scorpio Moon square with Aquarius Sun is the cold analysis-rejection of the "bright idea" of what Sun is endorsing. Since this is another Water-Air clash, emotions will be high, and weather conditions treacherous. Stay close to home if possible and use this energy for projects and relationships that haven't been getting your attention as they should.

*Saturday*, the 6th continues the tricky atmosphere with the 3:02 a.m. EST, Mercury (in Capricorn) sextile with Uranus (in Pisces). Expect surprise announcements or communications (as in abrupt actions). There could also be travel concerns and equipment dilemmas to add to the turmoil. At 7:13, Scorpio Moon then squares with Venus (in Aquarius). This isn't good for relationships or getting financing. At 8:36, Moon trines with Uranus (in Pisces), pulling its own fast move to counter what's happening. That's followed by Moon finally sextiling with Mercury (in Capricorn). Someone (or the opposing side) has gotten their message out. Since this is followed at 10:32 and 11:11 with squares against Chiron and Neptune (both in Aquarius), I would say that there is a sharp or fierce reaction against what's happened in the last two days, or those who have committed the actions in the first place. The Jupiter (in Pisces) sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn) indicates that. Heads may roll (e.g. pink slips/resignations) and, as usual, not everyone will get through the day breathing. Moon shifts into Sagittarius at 7:04.

*Sunday*, the 7th and at 2:55 a.m. EST, Sagittarius Moon sextiles with Saturn (in Libra). Rule and Law should be getting a respectful nod; however by 4:00, Moon is squaring with Jupiter (in Pisces) and at 7:21, Moon trines with Mars (in fellow Fire sign Leo). This is not a good sign for cooperation and respecting rules. I can see a very physical, even violent Super Bowl with a number of fouls being called. Lots of Air energy might suggest the passing game is what will have significant effect on the outcome. At 7:49, Aquarius Sun sextiles with Ceres (in Sagittarius). At 6:47 p.m. EST, Venus (in Aquarius) conjuncts with Chiron (also in Aquarius). I happen to find things to admire in both teams, but with Chiron present (the victim turned hero), my hunch is that the Saints could take this. Otherwise, this is also perfect atmosphere for aggression. We could see air travel incidents where someone/some try to get through security due to pre-occupied personnel, and to disrupt America's greatest past time. Let's pray not.
