

Planetary Forecast December 27, 2010-January 2,2011

*In review...*as predicted, the lunar eclipse (Gemini Moon and Sagittarius Sun) did have much to do with "matters of the general public" and the "loss or illness of noteworthy people." It was revealed this week that at least 31 cities in the U.S. have hexavalent chromium-tainted water including Norman, Ok., Honolulu, Ha., Riverside, Ca., Madison, Wisconsin, San Jose, Ca., Ann Arbor, Mi., Tallahassee and Miami, Fla., and Bend, Oregon. In addition Special Envoy Richard Holbrook passed after complications to torn aorta.

*This week..*with Libra Moon continuing our desire to focus on relationships and the beauty of the season, expect more impromptu lunches and dinners as we wind down the year to catch up with old friends and family. Do remember that Mercury is still in retrograde mode and Mars is feeling pretty grouchy and selfish, so between the good times there will be the incidents of conflict, even aggression. Since Mars will also take on law-abiding and principle-honoring Saturn, Wednesday could be the most difficult for those in domestic crisis. By the latter part of the week Scorpio Moon's water energy will bring weather concerns for those needing to head home. By New Year's Eve, Moon will be entering Sagittarius for a last bit of partying before we get back to business.

Monday, December 27th starts with the 5:49 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon opposition to Jupiter (in Pisces). Moon is feeling some fatigue and perhaps the flu is starting to spread in some regions at a faster pace. Pace yourself as "reality" starts to sink in again. At 5:54, Moon forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius) suggesting that we're trying only half-heartedly to keep the spirit of the season alive. The 7:21 opposition between Moon and Uranus (in Pisces) may help keep the weather system from getting too bad too quickly. Otherwise at 7:59, Moon will trine with Ceres (in Capricorn) and bodes well for domestic situations as many continue traveling home. Watch the 8:14 quincunx with Chiron (in Aquarius) though. That could be a bit of aggressive behavior by a few, but let's pray it's the thwarting of a potential attack. At 12:38 p.m. EST, Moon enters Libra. At 9:25, Libra Moon squares with Pluto (in Capricorn). Then we'll end with Moon's square with Capricorn Sun. Moon is not ready to say goodbye to the harmony and beauty of the season, but this is a strong energy to take on. This is a clash between ends and losses, return on investment, and air and earth energies. If you have to travel, do it before the noon hour. Avalanches and air travel could bring difficulties.

Tuesday the 28th has only three aspects, the 3:42 p.m. EST, Libra Moon square with Mars (in Capricorn), the 4:40, Moon trine with Saturn (in Libra), and the 10:17, Moon sextile with Mercury (in Sagittarius). Yes, there could be harsh words or actions between some, but Moon holds to the law and principle and the "message" as Mercury indicates, could be exactly what was hoped for/required for the greater good.

Wednesday, the 29th starts with the 9:20 a.m. EST, Libra Moon sextile with Jupiter (in Pisces). Yesterday's and the past's hard efforts should pay dividends now. At 10:05, Moon then trines with Neptune (in Aquarius). Do be careful not to paint too pretty a picture of things. The battle may be over, but not the war. That's evidenced by the 10:29, Mars (in Capricorn) square with Saturn (in Libra). Watch for those who don't

care for fairness or law. The 10:30, Moon quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces) is Moon striving not to lose ground now that some has been achieved. However, resist playing the victim card, which is what Moon tries at 11:31; however, the 12:31 p.m. EST Moon square with Ceres (in Capricorn) suggests some might and the results will test harmony. Moon shifts into Scorpio to ramp up emotions and weather systems at 3:49.

Thursday, the 30th and Mercury goes direct at 2:21 a.m. EST. Otherwise, at 12:56, Scorpio Moon trines with Pluto (in Capricorn). We could lose some from Mars' behavior yesterday, or due to rough travel conditions, or some last, but strong glitch in communications. Otherwise, at 6:51, Moon trines with Capricorn Sun and with Mars (also in Capricorn). Energy levels are high, as is passion. It's an industrious time for some to make early gains on 2011. Just pace yourself, and travel with care.

Friday, the 31st and New Year's Eve brings an 8:11 a.m. EST, Scorpio Moon conjunction with Venus (also in Scorpio). That's serious water energy--flooding or blizzard conditions where low pressure advances--and passionate conversations and interactions. That's it until 2:11 p.m. EST, when Moon trines with Jupiter (in Pisces). That's good luck and benevolence for the afternoon. However, Moon refuses to take anything for granted or paint too rosy a picture of any situation, as the 2:33, Moon square with Neptune (in Aquarius) suggests. By 2:57, Moon then trines with Uranus (in Pisces). Again, precipitation is heavy and surprises are possible. Don't take unnecessary chances. At 4:32, here comes Chiron (in Aquarius) squaring with Moon. Moon rejects the idea and instead sextiles with Ceres (in Capricorn) at 6:32. That's hopeful for family relationships and the earth. Weather systems could be playing out soon. We'll close as Moon enters Sagittarius at 8:21 for a cheerful and extremely upbeat closing to 2010.

Saturday, January 1, 2011 will not host any aspects. Hopefully that bodes well for New Years Day parades and bowl games.

Sunday, the 2nd will have us starting the day with the 2:21 a.m. EST, Sagittarius Moon sextile with Saturn (in Libra). Law and order seems to be holding. At 9:02, Moon the conjuncts with Mercury (in Sagittarius) and while that's a great deal of fire energy, which will help with optimism, at 8:45 p.m. EST, Moon gets a little carried away with the optimism and sextiles with Neptune (in Aquarius). Within four minutes, Moon then squares with Jupiter (in Pisces). Watch where you step or steer. You can be upbeat without stepping off a cliff. By 9:08, Moon also squares with Uranus (in Pisces). What started as a wonderful day, ends with unexpected loss. The 10:28 sextile between Moon and Chiron (in Aquarius) indicates we will try and see the cup half full, as things could be much worse, or someone's suffering is now behind them.
