

## Planetary Forecast January 25-31, 2010

*In review...*the warning about travel and accidents due to Pisces Moon (big Water energy), the presence of Pluto, along with some challenge to rules and such echoes hauntingly this week. A plane traveling from Florida to Ohio crashed killing three, another crashed in the Bahamas killing four, and on Sunday a passenger jet in Iran crashed. Early reports of the 170 onboard is that close to 50 are injured. Remember the lessons regarding the changes and moves momentum? How about Scott Brown (R-Massachusetts) winning Teddy Kennedy's seat in the senate? Tuesday was about tempers and the loss of control, and here came the news from near Appomattox, Virginia--a lone gunman killed eight. Thursday's tone of those who "will not be silenced" turned out to be independent voters again, sometimes in round-about ways. The results? Air American, the progressive radio talk show didn't have the audience they thought and had to file for bankruptcy, and Errol Sellers, the TBA nominee withdrew his nomination when it was exposed that he used FBI agents inappropriately. But hardly worried by the growing displeasure of the public, the Democrat-majority congress asks for the debt ceiling to be raised yet again. That was followed by the Friday "winds of war" atmosphere that I wrote of, and we learned the news that Great Britain has heightened their terror alert and Al Qaeda announces that they are going to start using pregnant women and women traveling with children as they continue to try to bring down commercial aircraft and disrupt mass transportation overall.

*This week...*tension escalates on all fronts, but particularly between males and females due to Venus being in rebellious Aquarius, and Mars in fiery Leo. Don't assume that because Mars is in retrograde that he's any weaker. This is stubbornness-compounded time and a take-no-prisoners atmosphere. *Monday* the 25th begins to end of January. Yes, one month in 2010 is about to join the history books--and as already indicated, it won't go quietly. We begin with the 6:11 a.m. EST, Moon shift into Gemini. At 9:09, Gemini Moon squares with Jupiter (in Pisces). This Air-Water clash is tough on travel, communications, electronics, and otherwise getting your message across. And didn't we hear President Obama rationalizing that the reason his healthcare support is tanking fast is because we weren't getting the chance to listen to him? The man has made more speeches than two presidents combined--it's what he is saying/wanting that is being rejected, but there's that "ego" thing that shuts his own ears. At 1:27 p.m. EST, Moon then forms a quincunx with Pluto (in Capricorn). Translate this momentum to your own lives and proceed with caution. As always those who are chronically ill may find their peace now, but this is also the atmosphere for resignations and pink slips. At 2:04, Moon trines with Saturn (in Libra). At 4:17, Moon trines with Aquarius Sun. The Saturn "embrace law" momentum and the Moon-Sun trine could be a sneak-attack thwarted, but watch the 8:40, Mercury (in Capricorn) quincunx with Mars (in Leo), and the 10:37, Moon trine with Venus (in Aquarius). Lip service and threats are going to be on the market for pennies a ton. Lower the volume and enjoy the evening with loved ones.

*Tuesday* the 26th starts with the 1:35 a.m. EST, Gemini Moon sextile with Mars (in Leo). At 2:06, Moon forms a quincunx with Venus (in Capricorn). At 6:59, Moon opposes Ceres (in Sagittarius). At 11:07 p.m. EST, Moon squares with Uranus (in Pisces). It won't be hard to find troublemakers and people who don't have your best interest in mind. This is a difficult atmosphere for domestic issues particularly where women and children are concerned. If Messenger Moon is going to square with Uranus, that's a clear signal that a suicide something is in the works. *Wednesday* the 27th gets busier again starting with the 12:34 a.m. EST, Gemini Moon trine with Chiron (in Aquarius). In five minutes, Venus (in Aquarius) will oppose Mars (in Leo). That's followed by the 1:32 Moon trine with Neptune (also in Aquarius). All that is justification time, when press releases or (in stand-off situations) the perpetrator explains why he needs to screw the world up even more. Then we'll have several hours break until Moon shifts into Cancer at 9:01. By 12:36 p.m. EST, Cancer Moon has its momentum and trines with Jupiter (in fellow Water sign Pisces). Aside from a fast increase of precipitation where Low Pressure advances, there is an opportunity to achieve an escape/rescue, and a windfall for some who step/negotiate with the highest discipline. At 3:56, Moon then opposes Pluto (in Capricorn). That window of three hours closes and at 4:20, Moon squares with Saturn (in Libra). That's a definite sign that the offer is off the table, or an assault is underway. We end with the 10:12, Moon quincunx with Aquarius Sun. Again, be careful traveling, and try to avoid reckless or ill-thought-out plans.

*Thursday*, the 28th starts slowly, not until the 5:03 a.m. EST, Cancer Moon quincunx with Venus (in Aquarius). Remember Pluto took a stand against Moon last night. Again--those who are chronically ill may no longer be among us. Watch for news of accidents and murder-suicides, particularly where domestic strife is concerned. Venus speaks to how we spend our money, as well. Some bill may be off the table or undergoing revision that sabotages women and children. At 7:21, Moon then opposes Mercury (in Capricorn). Moon is in an awfully crabby mood. At 9:34, Moon forms a quincunx with Ceres (in Sagittarius) and this clash of Water and Fire speak to weather accidents/crashes with life costs on top of the rest. We close with the 11:49 p.m. EST, Moon trine with Uranus (in Pisces). Here comes double Water energy and full-of-surprises Uranus. Travel should be curtailed if possible and those who are considering reconciliation or delay in separation, it would be a good idea to stop thinking anything is going to get better or that you can hang on to the status quo "for now."

*Friday*, the 29th and Full Moon time. Remember how we closed last night--well at 1:08 a.m. EST, Cancer Moon forms a quincunx with Chiron (in Aquarius). This is exactly what was warned of at the end of Thursday. Some will justify their awful actions claiming they were "forced." At 2:06, Moon does it again with Neptune (in Aquarius). At 9:10, Moon shifts into Leo. We are going from Water to Fire energy and lots more ego. Don't expect apologies and the "I get it" speech with "mea culpa" beats to the chest. The "whoever" of the world don't get it. At 1:21 p.m. EST, Leo Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Pisces). At 2:43, Aquarius Sun opposes Mars (in Leo). At 3:56, Moon

forms a quincunx with Pluto (in Capricorn). At 4:08, Moon sextiles with Saturn (Libra). The pattern is the same as always. The momentum is for someone, or some group to see himself/themselves as the victim/martyr and act accordingly. On the political front, watch for the White House/Congress spin on anything/everything. There's a great deal of tension in the air and the desire to let it rip both verbally and otherwise could yield strategy mistakes. For all of us, deep breaths and tabling critical decisions will help today/this weekend.

*Saturday*, the 30th and we begin with the 12:20 a.m. EST, Leo Moon conjunction with Mars (in Leo). No one is reining in their tempers or egos. At 1:18, Moon opposes Aquarius Sun--Full Moon for our side of the planet. Radical or outside-of-the-box behavior should be surprise. At 8:49, Moon opposes Venus (in Aquarius). This is not good for romance or the value of the dollar. At 10:09, Moon trines with Ceres (in Sagittarius). This is the anomaly in the day creating a scenario where the bad guys don't win every battle. If you find yourself in a critical situation, keep your wits about you. That includes where arson or fiery weather conditions prevail. Within the half hour, Moon forms a quincunx with Mercury (in Capricorn). *Sunday*, the 31st barely waits an hour before following Uranus' actions with a 12:34 a.m. EST, Leo Moon opposition with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 1:27, Moon also opposes Neptune (also in Aquarius). Standard fare--"You made me do it." It's 6:44 when the momentum changes and Venus (also in Aquarius) sextiles with Ceres (in Sagittarius). It should be noted that is just about when Barbara Walters will be anchoring the ABC This Week news program. Take from that what you will. At 8:23, Moon will shift into Virgo and the momentum for a retreat from the manic depressive nature should ease for the moment. However, so much is in the works that I think it will get worse before it gets better. At 1:19 p.m. EST, Virgo Moon opposes Jupiter (in Pisces). That doesn't bode well for funding and escaping all that's transpired. At 3:17, Moon trines with Pluto (in Capricorn). At 4:27, Saturn (in Libra) squares with Pluto (in Capricorn).
