

## Planetary Forecast for June 23<sup>rd</sup> -29<sup>th</sup>, 2008

*In review...*“weather, mischief and mayhem” did continue. Levees continue to fail along the Mississippi, and California fights fires, while in the Philippines a ferry capsizes in a typhoon and over 700 are missing from that incident alone. We won't get into the mischief part of things; suffice it to say we live among monsters and this is a period where they “ignite” too easily.

*This week...*Monday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> launches a period that will have us seeing Uranus going retrograde (Thursday). If you thought we were getting a break now that Mercury is going forward, don't bet the bank on it. What to expect? A repeat of May tendencies and that means more weather-related and emotional challenges because Uranus continues to reside in Water sign Pisces for all of this year. On a personal and professional level, old issues related to the wisdom of past choices may convince some to give up on certain expectations. That's not necessarily a bad thing. *Otherwise...*at 4:14 a.m. EDT, Aquarius Moon conjuncts with Neptune (in Aquarius). If this isn't a wild or mad idea about to spiral out of control, I don't know what and look what follows—the 3:04 p.m. EDT, Moon sextile with Pluto (in Sagittarius) also a Fire sign. At 3:32 p.m. , Moon enters Pisces, which will increase the momentum for rain where Low's exist and sensitivity where emotional turmoil are heightened. *Tuesday* the 24<sup>th</sup> brings only two aspects—typical after a hard aspect day. First the 5:28 a.m. EDT, Pisces Moon trine with Venus (in Cancer). Not perfect, but wiser heads prevail, so says the 3:20 Pisces Moon sextile with Jupiter (in Capricorn). At 9:35, Moon conjuncts with Uranus (also in Pisces). Remember, though, that Uranus is not himself right now, so what exactly is he selling/endorsing? It's all in the details, my friends. At 4:38 p.m. EDT, Moon forms a quincunx with Mars (in Leo). *Thursday* the 26<sup>th</sup> and we enter the fourth quarter of Moon. At 6:09 a.m. EDT, Aries Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Virgo) and that should be a shocker to no one. Rules, restrictions, and détente' are all in jeopardy. At 8:10, Moon squares with Cancer Sun indicating that along with possible heat storms, someone's heart could get ripped out or at

least fried to a crisp. The second hint is the 5:21 p.m., Moon square with Venus (in Cancer). Not a good day for women in relationships or mothers with children who are a handful. At 8:01 p.m. EDT, Uranus (in Pisces) turns retrograde. Just a little napalm dressing on that salad.

*Friday*, the 27<sup>th</sup> begins with the 1:39 a.m. EDT, Aries Moon sextile with Mercury (in Gemini). Voices will be heard. Whose and why will be part of why at 8:05, Moon squares with Jupiter (in Capricorn) shutting down financing and all kinds of other support. Well, what did you expect with such thoughtless rhetoric? At 10:51, Moon sextiles with Chiron in Aquarius). If Plan A didn't work, don't be surprised when someone reminds us of old wounds and prejudices. Isn't it time we put the Catch 22 and Get Out of Jail card into the trash where it belongs and everyone take responsibility for their actions? There's a pipe dream. At 4:49 p.m. EDT, Moon sextiles with Neptune (in Aquarius) more waxing eloquent to convince the gullible. At 11:18, Moon trines with Mars (in Leo) stirring the warrior pot. Is this the other side reacting to the 4:49 sextile? You betcha. And gas is what per barrel today at the close of the market today?

*Saturday*, the 28<sup>th</sup> begins with the 2:14 a.m. EDT, Taurus Moon trine with Pluto (in Sagittarius) and that's Earth and Fire cooperating. Actually, Moon doesn't shift into Taurus until 2:50, but in this Void Course period, it's reacting more to Taurus than Aries. At 10:02, Taurus Moon trines with Saturn (in Virgo) and here's an opportunity to get balanced again and grounded. *Sunday*, the 29<sup>th</sup> at 12:58 a.m. EDT, Taurus Moon sextiles with Venus (in Cancer). Anyone who wants to muddy those waters expect to be shut down for at 12:43 p.m. EDT, Moon squares with Chiron (in Aquarius). We need a break and whiners and troublemakers should beware. Walking the plank may no longer be in fashion, but bad karma has its own trigger switch. At 4:11, Moon sextiles with Uranus (in Pisces), then at 6:18, Moon squares with Neptune (in Aquarius).
