

## Planetary Forecast for June 1-7, 2009

*In review...*Monday's Gemini Moon-Saturn square (opposing law and borders) did occur when North Korea not only triggered a nuclear underground test, but also tested two more short-range missiles. As for busy Moon and retrograding Mercury, the big chatter and wooing could easily be evidenced in President Obama's nomination of New York Judge Sonia Sotomayor for the Supreme Court. Was that the correct choice for the country? Time will tell. Usually with a retrograde we have to revisit a situation again. Pluto's presence guaranteed not all would make it through the day/week and most notable (and tragic) of our losses was that of Mike Tyson's four-year-old daughter, who was strangled in an exercise equipment accident.

*This week...*Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup> is another active day beginning at 2:36 a.m. EDT when Virgo Moon forms a quincunx with Venus (in Aries). At 4:29, Moon again is in quincunx mode this time with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 4:32, Moon opposes Uranus (in Pisces). At 4:55, Moon gets back into "forcing" mode with a quincunx with Neptune (also in Aquarius). At 5:21, Moon repeats that move with Ceres (also in Aquarius). Many will feel a bit nervous and on the receiving end of criticism until the moon change. Strive not to lose your cool and know that you can still maintain your own counsel. The last aspect of the morning is the 11:17 Moon shift into Libra. Tempers should ease as the day progresses, but if someone asks you to forgive and forget an injustice that may be more than you can do at the moment. At 12:21 p.m. EDT, Libra Moon forms a quincunx with Mars (in Taurus). Even Libra Moon can find its temper switch. With the 3:51, Moon square with Pluto (in Capricorn), this could be one of those moments when Moon cuts ties with something or someone. Do watch your health and your safety.

*Tuesday*, the 2<sup>nd</sup> begins with the 5:34 a.m. EDT, Venus (in Aries) sextile with Chiron (in Aquarius). Are we in the mood to embrace or finance the victim or the hero? Fire and Air energy are enabling each other. Add the 9:27, Aquarius Moon trine with Gemini Sun and we could be hearing a good deal about/from those feeling empowered. At 11:54, Venus then sextiles with Neptune (also in Aquarius) suggesting speeches could be getting extremely saccharin as some put a too-good-to-be-true spin on things. It's 7:39 p.m. EDT before the next and last aspect--the Venus sextile with Jupiter (in Aquarius). Whatever navigating and maneuvering went on today, it was apparently successful. The wallet and heart has been opened. It would be wiser to follow your instincts rather than join in with the rousing chorus of sheep.

*Wednesday*, the 3<sup>rd</sup> and things get busier again starting with the 6:07 a.m. EDT, Libra Moon quincunx with Mercury (in Taurus). Following the benevolence that started last night, Moon will attempt to diplomatically change someone's mind. The "who" is problematic considering the 11:37, Moon trine with Chiron (in Aquarius). Remember that Chiron went into retrograde momentum last week, so issues of the past regarding principle and the concept of what is fair may need to be addressed. Don't expect overnight resolutions, as these are long-term problems. In ten minutes, Moon then forms another quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). Now Libra is more about coercion than forcing, so the surprise may come in the "how" that happens. By 12:05 p.m. EDT, Moon then trines with Neptune (in Aquarius). Again, some are in positive spin mode., which may be a hard pill to swallow. But within the hour, Moon trines with Jupiter (also in Aquarius) indicating possible success/funding for whatever is going on. At 2:00 p.m. EDT, Moon opposes Venus (in Aries). On the surface that seems like a contradiction. Having won benevolence it isn't like Moon to shut the wallet or heart. We could be looking at two different situations that some are juggling. It would be like getting an extension on a loan, but then turning down the offer to pick up a car at a bargain price because you know you're not in condition to

deal with more debt. If this is about relationships, some will get support on an issue and shut the door on someone trying to undermine them. At 6:44, Moon shifts into Scorpio. During this cycle, look at where you were last month during Full Scorpio Moon. All eyes were on the hostage sea captain being held by Somalian pirates. Anger had found its threshold again and there was another college shooting, while weather and fires were causing upheaval and heartbreak. At 11:19, Moon opposes Mars (in Taurus). Water, Earth, and Fire energy are at odds. This could mean more weather problems or environmental incidents like a volcanic eruption. At 11:23, we end with Scorpio Moon in sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn). Again, not everyone will get through the day, but this is also an opportunity to purge what isn't working in your life.

*Thursday* the 4<sup>th</sup> starts with the 12:37 a.m. EDT, Mars (in Taurus) trine with Pluto (in Capricorn). That is double Earth energy and fiery Mars giving the momentum for the event. If this isn't about an environmental event, check on those in troubled domestic situations. At 11:19, Scorpio Moon then sextiles with Ceres (in Virgo). At 10:30 p.m. EDT, Moon then forms a quincunx with Gemini Sun. Some are challenging assertions and claims of others. If you're dealing with someone not exactly honest or following the rule of law, the 11:44, Moon sextile with Saturn (in Virgo) indicates you will get things corrected or them shut down.

*Friday*, the 5<sup>th</sup> is slow to begin activity. That's another hint that yesterday is serious. It's 3:10 p.m. EDT when Gemini Sun squares with Saturn (in Capricorn). Sun does not like being caught and is fighting back hard. Watch for what North Korea is doing or if the Sotomayor senate hearings have started. At 4:56, Scorpio Moon is opposed to Mercury (in Taurus), and rightfully so. A half truth is still deceit. At 8:59, Moon squares with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 9:18, Moon trines with Uranus (in Pisces). In eleven minutes, Moon then squares with Neptune (also in Aquarius). At 10:18, we end with the Moon square with Jupiter (also in Aquarius). Mercury and Sun are getting themselves into hot water. If you don't want to get burned, do not participate.

*Saturday*, the 6<sup>th</sup> and at 4:20 a.m. EDT, Scorpio Moon forms a quincunx with Venus (in Aries). Aside from weather issues, funding and emotional support is being withdrawn or there are serious strings attached. In four minutes, Moon shifts into Sagittarius. At 4:07, Venus enters Taurus. At 12:54 p.m. EDT, Sagittarius Moon forms a quincunx with Mars (in Taurus). At 10:59, Moon squares with Ceres (in Virgo). This Fire Moon attempts to undo what Scorpio achieved. Discipline is no fun. Watch for talk behind your back, or worse.

*Sunday* the 7 and there are only two aspects, the first occurring at 10:36 a.m. EDT when Sagittarius Moon squares with Saturn (in Virgo). Breaking rules and going against the law is costly and dangerous. With Full Moon occurring at 2:12 p.m. EDT (Sagittarius Moon opposing Gemini Sun) the "crazies" will be out in full force.
