

Planetary Forecast March 1-7, 2010

In review.. that stronger earthquake activity forecasted appeared even earlier than expected. On Friday a 6.9 quake hit off the coast of Japan, and by Saturday morning an 8.8, 6.2, and 6.9 series of quakes hit off the shore of Chile. Then, I warned that by Saturday, the president's female aides and staffers would be in front of the cameras, but one won't be for long--Desiree Rogers, the White House Social Secretary will be "stepping down." This follows much criticism of security breaches at WH functions. Also as warned, while Gemini Moon and Mercury were active, communications and denial were the two big themes. Interestingly, Rep. Charles Rangel is finally being held accountable for the first of many questionable ethics/financial matters, and Gov. David Paterson of NY is ending his campaign to serve for a full term after allegations of using his seat to sway matters in an ugly domestic violence case involving one of his closest staffers. And as always with lots of Water energy, winter storms dumped up to three feet of snow in the northeast, and created a new wave of problems in Texas.

This week... with Mercury entering Pisces and Scorpio Moon coming during the week, the momentum for a new series of winter weather will torture those waiting for daffodils and tulips. In addition, we'll see communication changes and perception changes due to this Mercury shift. We saw how nonstop communication was while Mercury spent three weeks in Aquarius--and how innovative, though not always wise and well thought out. Now Mercury is asked to forego some of its usual logic to accept that *any* idea is better than what is currently established. Proceed with caution. This could be an expensive and possibly dangerous for those who are too trusting, as well as gullible. Venus will also be shifting houses--from romantic Pisces to fiery Aries. While this could be good news for those wanting more passion than tender romance in their lives, be warned that this environment could create aggressive and angry relationships--some with almost childish reasoning behind it, or at the least selfish, since as the first sign of the zodiac, Aries is known for its childlike enthusiasm, and "me-me-Me!" focus.

Monday, March 1st is ultra busy starting with the 7:32 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon opposition to Venus (in Pisces). Here's the first declaration by Moon acting as comptroller or accountant that something is too costly to support. At 8:28, Mercury then shifts into Pisces, and here starts the message that, "Oh, it's not *too* bad. In the long run, it'll be cheaper." At 12:23 p.m. EST, Moon squares with Ceres (in Sagittarius). Moon has her hands full being the stern taskmaster and keeping everyone else in the zodiac from rushing headlong into bankruptcy. In thirteen minutes, Moon opposes Uranus (in Pisces). That's another veto for whatever idea/bill being proposed. At 2:15, Moon then forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius), as usual followed by another quincunx with Chiron (also in Aquarius) before the hour ends. We should all be used to this activity because as soon as some hear, "No," they start wailing, "Abuse!" At 7:14, Mercury (in Pisces) echoes that move with Mars (in Leo). This could be clever, but a little dangerous, or at the least back-stabbing. In seventeen minutes, Moon then shifts into Libra. Libra Moon gets to work faster than expected at 8:45 in a sextile with Mars (in Leo). At 8:58, we end with Moon's quincunx with Mercury (in Pisces). This is exactly what I was speaking of earlier: while Libra Moon is usually all-embracing and diplomatic to a fault, agendas are agendas and certain underdeveloped individuals won't mind

throwing someone under the bus, or at least tripping someone else up as a means to an end.

Tuesday the 2nd and we'll start early with the 12:02 a.m. EST, Libra Moon conjunction with Saturn (in Libra). This is plenty of Air energy to dry up conditions where Low Pressure has saturated the region. Otherwise, the experts say yesterday's energy will carry into today, but if Moon is finally embracing Saturn, and there's the 2:53, Uranus (in Pisces) square with Ceres (in Sagittarius), followed by a 3:44 Moon square with Pluto (in Capricorn), my hunch is that someone's head is going to roll for that series of conduct. Think Ram Emanuel, Obama's Chief of Staff, or more pressure against Charlie Rangel, etc. Note that due to Pluto's hefty "culling" energy, there's almost a nine-hour lull as we recover/stabilize and at 12:13 p.m. EST, Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Pisces). At 3:16 Moon does the same with Pisces Sun. Whatever is going on more adjustments or a surrender ends the day with the 10:13, Mercury (in Pisces) quincunx with Saturn (in Libra). Someone is trying to stop serious "blood loss" in order to convince the public/majority that they are deserving of trust. Interestingly, this is more about fixing or disguising a symptom and not admitting the problem is terminal.

Wednesday the 3rd will be more active again, but starts late with the 1:13 p.m. EST, Libra Moon quincunx with Venus (in Pisces). At 2:03 in the afternoon, Moon does the same with Uranus (in Pisces). Within a half hour, Moon then sextiles with Ceres (in Sagittarius). At 3:43, Moon trines with Neptune (in Aquarius). At 4:32, Moon trines with Chiron. These aspects all speak to damage control and the next attempt to woo, urge, or buy support. Expect to hear of more promises being made behind closed doors. Creativity-wise, the atmosphere is helpful and hopeful. At 9:11, Moon enters Scorpio, which changes the brief respite from critical-mass negativity and brings out the energy of the opposition. At 10:09, Scorpio Moon squares with Mars (in Leo). This could be putting on the brakes of some bill, or the exposure of the latest terrorist plot. At 11:07, Venus (in Pisces) conjuncts with Uranus (in Pisces). Money or funding is being tweaked, so if someone previously not onboard with something could suddenly be announced as bought and paid for. Otherwise, precipitation is on the upswing--like it wasn't already.

Thursday, the 4th will launch with the 5:53 a.m. EST, Scorpio Moon trine with Mercury (in Pisces). At 6:00, Moon then sextiles with Pluto (in Capricorn). Before the hour is up, Mercury (in Pisces) will deliver that message as it sextiles with Pluto also. Something or someone is over--either Obama (and company) will opt for the "reconciliation" clause and blast his health care bill through congress regardless of what the GOP, moderate Democrats and public thinks, or there's something else historic occurring. At 9:05, Venus (in Pisces) squares with Ceres (in Sagittarius)--either way that's worries for our finances, women, and families. This strikes me as new/further economy/budget/treasury problems, but there's the violence thing to consider, as well. At 3:56 p.m. EST, Scorpio Moon trines with Jupiter (in Pisces). Despite the previous momentum, Moon has luck with holding some feet to the fire. At 10:21, Moon trines with Pisces Sun. This is a great deal of moisture momentum (snow and rain) and also a

powerful opportunity for creative artists, gaining insight via dreams, and using our too-often-ignored sixth sense.

Friday, the 5th aspects don't begin until the 7:06 p.m. EST, Scorpio Moon trine with Uranus. Expect the unexpected, and be very careful while partying tonight, especially when meeting new people. The 8:50, Scorpio Moon square with Neptune (in Aquarius) would suggest someone is not who he presents himself to be. At 9:50, Moon squares with Chiron, and we'll end with the 11:32, Moon trine with Mars (in Uranus). The momentum for aggression is in the air, as well. Those who are experiencing domestic trouble need to watch out, too.

Saturday, the 6th starts with the 2:36 a.m. EST, Moon shift into Sagittarius, which serves to dry out areas where Low Pressure has departed and to bump up our energy momentum. That comes with the other side of the spectrum, however. Watch for people who are too loud, stir the pot, and ignore rules because they're for other people. Interestingly, the first aspect of the day is the 3:22, Sagittarius Moon trine with Mars (in Leo). So, not only will we be seeing clearing skies for some, but Moon is in the mood to take back some ground lost over the last few days. Be careful of those who are out to only please themselves regardless of what is claimed. This could also bring on news of attacks and arson due to the triple Fire energy. But it's great for getting chores done--if spring cleaning is a possibility. At 7:13, Moon then sextiles with Saturn (in Libra). That looks promising, although this feels more like lip service due to the 10:47, Neptune (in Aquarius) sextile with Ceres (in Sagittarius). Take off the rose-colored glasses and think hard on an offer before you accept and sign away your freedom and paycheck. At 8:55, Moon then squares with Mercury (in Pisces), which is a difficult clash with the Messenger. Who's telling the truth? Certainly not the one embracing the glass-half-full concept. At 11:58, Moon squares with Jupiter (in Pisces), which indicates there's not much luck for what Moon is touting right now.

Sunday, the 7th will have Venus moving into Aries at 7:33 a.m. EST, followed by the 10:42, Sagittarius Moon square with Pisces Sun. This is followed by the 2:15 p.m. EST, Venus (in Aries) trine with Mars (in Leo). Energy and socializing may be on the upswing, but it will be clear that some are only seriously interested in their own success. It's shades of, "If you're not with us, you're against us" momentum, and compassion is pretty much out the window. That said, we'll end with the 8:45, Mercury (in Pisces) conjunction with Jupiter (in Pisces). Messages do seem to be hitting the right notes for some and reaping rewards.
