

Planetary Forecast for March 3-9, 2008

*In review...*sadly, the momentum for “acting instead of reasoning” was illustrated in no less than six multiple slayings from New York, to Oklahoma, to Arkansas, to Texas all either domestic related, or else the victims knew the perpetrators. While I mentioned that by Saturday earthquake energy would be increasing, stronger activity occurred all week—and in areas that don’t often see such environmental conditions including England, New York, and north of Holland.

*This week...*we’ll find that Air energy isn’t about to give up yet. Surprise, surprise as Spring approaches, time for serious storms and increasing political momentum. First, however, we begin at 1:16 a.m. EST with Capricorn Moon’s sextile with Uranus (in Pisces). That’s Earth and Water raising increased possibilities for heavier and wilder weather where Low Pressure systems prevail, but also a last minute bottom-line maneuvering attempt in the political theater. At 11:16 p.m. EST, Moon forms a quincunx with Mars (in Gemini) confirming the power-play momentum for someone trying to “muscle” their way into gaining control. Moon then goes only briefly in void course before shifting into Air sign Aquarius at 11:24—a clue that what goes on today and for the next 72 hours is well thought out (this is not fuzzy thinking time) and will be highly active carrying the great wind push of that sign to make things happen. As troubling and costly as it will be for some, and successful as it will be for others, it’s fascinating to watch it unfold before our eyes.

Tuesday the 4th and Mars, now completely direct and out of its storm period, enters Cancer at 5:01 a.m. EST. For the evolved souls understanding opportunity, this is a perfect period to recognize nature’s vitamin pill and move forward on creative projects and family/nurturing needs. This momentum will grow over the next several weeks, meaning don’t stress if you don’t recognize change overnight. Understand also that those things/people that have been dragging you down, should now get the hint that conditions have changed and there will be no more of that. At 7:40, Aquarius Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn in (Virgo) and that’s a hint that at least somewhere innovation or law-breaking will be used to gain a desired outcome. Is it right or fair? All that we do know is that it’s Super Tuesday II, and you can expect the talking heads on TV will be full of opinions—and mostly stealing each others lines. While we’re witnessing these events that will be effecting all of us, it wouldn’t be unseemly to feel sympathy for the gullible, and frustration for the apathetic.

Wednesday the 5th and it’s a momentous and rare day in astrology, a Grand Cross day, meaning all conjunctions (at least four “planets,” including Moon and Chiron) are between 0 and 8 degrees of each other. That’s harmony for some universal purpose. Good or bad? Depends who you are and what you are looking for from this world. Will this momentum succeed? Probably; after all, we’re talking about anything goes Aquarius Moon, who also believes rules are for everyone else, which suggests a serious frustration or heartbreaker for some. This is how it lays out...first at 12:37 a.m. EST, Mercury (also in Aquarius) conjuncts with Chiron (also in Aquarius). At 8:27, Moon conjuncts with Chiron (also in Aquarius). Remember that the big asteroid is known to be a maverick and represented by the centaur in mythology. Chiron travels between Saturn and Uranus and is seen as the removal of the handicap, also a bridge. Now who in politics did their astrology research and uses the “Bridge to the Future” sermon? They won’t admit it, but someone in the tiers has an astrologer’s input/guidance. This *cannot* be an accident. That said, who then is the candidate who represents the real bridge? In fact we have three candidates who qualify. At 9:05 Moon conjuncts with Mercury. At 2:10 p.m. EST, Moon conjuncts with Venus (also in Aquarius). At 4:46 p.m. EST, Moon conjuncts with Neptune (also in Aquarius) and if this

isn't an invitation for the voting public to drift into an escapist atmosphere, here it is.

Thursday the 6th and now Moon shifts into Pisces at 5:53 a.m. EST. At 7:04, Pisces Moon then trines with Mars (in Cancer) and that doubles the momentum for precipitation where Low Pressure Systems reside. While this continues and increases creativity opportunities, there also exists a troubling temper tantrum environment. Everyone should take their environment and relationships seriously because what follows is Moon in sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn) at 7:33. Yes, by all means clear the air and communicate. Those who are in harmony and are grounded spiritually, you will be fine; but keep an eye out for those who are continuing to reject or at least butt heads against not only the status quo, but deeper society mores, as well. This atmosphere could trip some sensitive psychological switches. Sadly, these are also avalanche and mudslide conditions. At 1:20 P.M. EST, Moon opposes Saturn (in Virgo) which isn't the smartest behavior for the often praised "wise" sign. We'll need to see the what and why. At 2:04, Pisces Sun trines with Jupiter (in Capricorn) and that could mean some taking care of special interests at the expense of the majority. I'd like to say this is a universal "gift" to the whole, but not after Moon disses Mr. Responsibility. At 7:02, we close with the Venus (in Aquarius) conjunction with Neptune (in Aquarius). Once again the dream or ideal is being nurtured. This is going to prove fine for some, but the majority have to figure out Christmas can't last 365 days a year.

Friday, the 7th and it's New Moon time...starting at 4:11 a.m. EST with Mars (in Cancer) opposing Pluto (in Capricorn). At 10:54 a.m. EST, Pisces Moon sextiles with Jupiter (in Capricorn). At 12:14 p.m. EST Pisces Moon conjuncts with Pisces Sun--New Moon. At 2:04, Moon conjuncts with Uranus (also in Pisces). The weather energy continues to map eastward, and the need to end some costly and unhealthy patterns is being ignored or rejected. This environment is best for finishing projects and philosophical analysis. But this is the 7th, a very beneficial or costly spiritual day, and Pluto will return tomorrow. Something is up and with Aries gaining more control in hours the energy is there for success. This is either international reaction to the primaries earlier in the week (terrorism strikes increasing), or someone who objects to the results nationally (not unlike the ricin mess in Nevada). On a personal basis, seek out the promise of Spring, but be cautious if attending larger gatherings. With Mars this strong, anyone in a difficult domestic situation the need to assume the worst is simply a given.

Saturday, the 8th...and at 9:23 a.m. EST, Moon enters Aries. At 11:02, Aries Moon squares with Pluto (in Capricorn). At 11:45, Moon squares with Mars (in Cancer). At 3:19, Pisces Sun conjuncts with Uranus (in Pisces). At 4:15, Aries Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Virgo). Perhaps to build a better garden it is necessary to yank out the twenty foot tree in the yard, but understand there are no shortcuts to healing. Use this period best for taking the first steps to break bad habits or addictions.

Sunday the 9th and at 4:52 a.m. EST, Mercury (in Aquarius) conjuncts with Neptune (in Aquarius) and that's Air energy gifting the planet of gab to get things said that need to be but in the gentlest (or flattering) manner. At 2:52 p.m. EST, Aries Moon squares with Jupiter (in Capricorn) indicating if conversations don't go well, some wallets or doors will be slammed. At 4:50 p.m. EST, Moon sextiles with Chiron (in Aquarius) trying for a different approach (or bridge) to success. That may be possible, but remember even Achilles and Hercules failed at some point.
