

## Planetary Forecast for May 7-13, 2007

*In review...*the warning to avoid angry people and to lock away weapons last week frequently didn't find traction; for example in Jacksonville, Florida six teens were shot/injured by another teen seeking revenge over a "girl" issue, and there were plenty others like that. Some of that anger may prove difficult to regret what with the news that Al Qaeda's # 1 in Iraq has "allegedly" been killed by the man seeking revenge for *his* family's deaths. Time will tell on that one, but add Neptune to the mix along with fuzzy thinking/focus, and among other incidents that played out with regretful predictability is a record number of school bus accidents--three in twenty-four hours. Then there's the weather issues that accompany these aspects; add Pluto's grim presence and, sadly, the tornado count by Sunday morning is already an astonishing 100 in the Plains. At least 60 souls have been lost. Finally, as I write this, bodies are still being pulled out of the sea after a Haitian boat capsizes, and in Cameroon a Kenya Airlines 737 with 114 onboard remains missing. On a positive note the Kentucky Derby did happen and with the Queen of England in presence; Jupiter was cooperating (in a conjunction); and the odds-on favored horse won. Thanks for a great deal of Sagittarius Fire energy that dried things off just enough to have an almost sunny race.

*This week...*Monday, May 7<sup>th</sup> begins with the 10:28 a.m. EDT square between Mercury (in Taurus) and Neptune (in Aquarius). This is twelve hours after the Sunday opposition between Venus and Pluto and it appears for many the relationship factors that fractured last night/week will continue into the morning. (If meaty enough, it may own the news headlines.) Aside from a repeat of weather heartache, watch for what war and weather stress does for already unhealthy relationships. Politically speaking, there's a 1:12 p.m. EDT trine between Capricorn Moon and Taurus Sun (double Earth energy) suggesting that those wanting a summary for expenses and time invested will dig in their heels deeper than ever. (Iraq military funding talk anyone?) Next, Moon sextiles with Uranus (in Pisces) at 3:11 and that could be another sneak attack by a leader (Capricorn) to achieve a goal. Expect exchanges such as, "I don't think I said that...this is what I mean," and learn *that* latest attempt at clarity is still a sinkhole getting the taxpayers nowhere. At 4:20 Moon then forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Leo) and that's a hint that what was intended all along was the end goal, but depending on the "winds" of fate, who knows if the strategy will be effective; after all we are dealing--at least politically--with slugs whose shells are cemented in clay regardless of what rhetoric is spewing from their mouths.

*Tuesday, May 8<sup>th</sup>* will bring sign changes along with busy aspects beginning with the 1:23 a.m. EDT trine between Capricorn Moon and Mercury (in Taurus) so when you find yourself at the receiving end of terse (or worse) comments, that's part of why. Whether chatty or retiring, Earth people are opinionated if not blunt. Venus then leaves machinations-master Gemini and enters Cancer at 3:28; expect to feel the gamut of emotions from euphoria to thin-skinned-postal rather quickly. The question remaining to those connected to an IV with Venus: do we really have to participate in those 24/7 high dramas? In six minutes Moon then sextiles with Mars (in Pisces); Moon is weak here and that gives Mars way too much leeway to stir up trouble, including storms. Moon enters Aquarius at 1:48 p.m. EDT and here comes Air energy, that's wind/storms as much as increasing our restlessness and impulses for change for change's sake. An hour later Aquarius Moon forms a quincunx with Venus (in Cancer)--oops. Already someone's toes got stepped on--and aside from tears, watch those radars for an increased threat of significant weather. Taurus Sun then sextiles with Uranus (in Pisces) at 4:25. At 8:39 Mercury (in Taurus) sextiles with Mars (in Pisces) and that's fiery language whether it's political or the universe voicing its opinion via weather. For those in vulnerable Low Pressure areas, please don't take unnecessary risks or foolishly think "it won't happen to me." Finally, we get to close the day with the 11:10 Taurus Sun quincunx with Jupiter (in

Sagittarius) and that's heartening. Perhaps a storm will weaken in time to save a town, an arson-lit fire will fail to achieve the devastation intended, or an earthquake may not hurt the populace. Any and all of these would be huge gifts.

**Wednesday** the 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:05 a.m. EDT Taurus Sun squares with Saturn (in Leo). That's the day until 10:28 p.m. EDT when Aquarius Moon sextiles with Jupiter (in Sagittarius). So what's this? Expect some fast talk/movement by opportunists and saboteurs, but try not to declare WWII over it. In view of the vision of most these days, the guilty are as likely to blow themselves up (hopefully rhetorically) as to injure anyone else. We close with an 11:19 opposition between Moon and Saturn (in Leo) and that speaks to the Office of Accounts and Balances putting the brakes on any more erratic talk/behavior.

**Thursday** the 10<sup>th</sup>, some may not have listened and we begin early with a 12:27 a.m. EDT square between Aquarius Moon and Taurus Sun bringing an Air-Earth conflict that means environmentally and emotionally "something's gotta give." At 5:27 watch for Moon to conjunct with Neptune (also in Aquarius) to put what? Too much gloss on a bad scenario or to hoodwink the gullible into further danger? Now here comes Pluto (in Sagittarius) and Mercury (in Taurus) at 12:56 p.m. EDT to send a death knell message. Pluto's not resting yet. At 5:02 Pluto sextiles with Aquarius Moon. Sound good? Uh-uh because in 45 minutes Moon then squares with the messenger Mercury (in Taurus)--some idea/communication didn't work. Air energy is really rough this season and that goes for dialogues as much as weather concerns. At 7:31 Moon shifts into Pisces slowing the pace greatly, but also putting many into denial or making others overly nostalgic. The thing to reach for now is to seek inner wisdom and rely on our inner guide. Pay attention to dreams and heed that sixth sense or other instincts. On the bright side, those evolved will be benefited by the 11:32 Jupiter (in Sagittarius) square with Uranus (in Pisces) to hopefully stop something harmful or otherwise depleting.

**Friday** the 11<sup>th</sup> at 1:06 a.m. EDT Pisces Moon trines with Venus (in Cancer) bringing double Water energy and that's lots of opportunity for rain, but also for tears or paralyzing emotionality. Otherwise, the only aspect of the day is the 5:17 a.m. Mercury shift into home-ground Gemini. Again, this kind of slow shifting means we are given time to get our grounding and take stock of all that has happened. Unfortunately, if you look at the world in general, there's a great deal to wrap the mind around. Things to look forward to are important dialogues and contracts/plans set in place before Mercury heads into retrograde.

**Saturday** the 12<sup>th</sup> brings a 2:03 a.m. EDT Pisces Moon square with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) and it's another opportunity for Water and Fire to collide, followed in fifteen minutes by the Moon conjunction with Uranus (also in Pisces). Anyone overseas needs to "watch the other guy," while on this continent watch for weather or going home from a date with "Mr. Goodbar." At 3:20, Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Leo) to add the inner resolve not test boundaries. Moon and Sun sextile to begin Moon's Fourth Quarter at 8:01; finish up IOU's and try some yoga to cleanse the mind. There's an almost twelve hour status quo energy-wise until Moon conjuncts with Mars (in Pisces) bringing more double Water energy to worry about everything from flooding to emotional tsunamis. Then by 7:53 p.m. Moon squares with Pluto (in Sagittarius). See what I mean? Batten the hatches weather-wise, and if you opened the door to a stranger because he asked, be grateful if you wake up in the morning. Ready or not, Moon enters feisty Aries at 10:29, while stalwart Taurus Sun squares with unfocused Neptune (in Aquarius) at 10:56.
