

Planetary Forecast April 26-May 2, 2010

Apologies for the delay in getting this posted. The southwest had a rough weekend weather-wise, including here. Thankfully, we suffered nominal damage compared to those poor souls in Mississippi, but were without power until yesterday evening.

*This week...*Mercury is operating at full retrograde speed. Remember not to sign any important documents until May 11th and expect schedule glitches and equipment/appliance repairs. Also on Wednesday it will be Full Moon time again. This is a serious one and could bring out the dark side in some. It's best to apply this energy to severing ties with those individuals and ceasing activities that either aren't good for us and are otherwise detrimental to our well being.

Monday, April 26th begins with the 1:07 a.m. EDT, Libra Moon square with Pluto (in Capricorn). It's not a good time for relationships that are already fractured. Trying to charm someone at 2:08 (Moon quincunx with Taurus Sun) will be tougher than we think--thankfully the hour suggests this is more about overseas behavior than here. By 8:23, Moon is again working associates and trying to rescue something/someone that isn't being cooperative (quincunx with Mercury in Taurus). The 10:10, Moon sextile with Mars (in Leo) indicates something is achieved due to either great enthusiasm or a little strong-arming behind closed doors. Take note--the 7:23 p.m. EDT opposition between Saturn (in Virgo) to Uranus (in Pisces) indicates a few weather and relationship concerns.

Tuesday the 27th continues the arbitration and diplomacy momentum beginning with the 6:45 a.m. EDT quincunx between Libra Moon and Jupiter (in Pisces). Although that bodes well for progress, understand that not everything is being disclosed--so says the 3:45 p.m. EDT trine between Moon and Neptune (in Aquarius). At 4:28 p.m., Moon forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). Expect the unexpected idea-wise, but take your time implementing them. At 6:28, Moon enters Scorpio. Before the hour is out, Moon trines with Chiron (in Pisces). This is tricky, but the momentum for being cautious about activities and relationships is kicking into gear.

Wednesday the 28th and things get much busier. We begin with the 12:38 a.m. EDT quincunx between Scorpio Moon and Venus (in Gemini). Moon is likely to be extremely frank, so don't ask questions unless you want to hear what someone really thinks. Passions are running high. At 2:22, Moon sextiles with Ceres (in Capricorn). The empowerment of women and families seems to be in order and by 3:30, some seem to be saying, "Had enough, so long," indicated by the Moon sextile with Pluto (also in Capricorn). Do be aware that can have some negative reactions and safety is an issue. Otherwise, almost five hours later at 8:19, Scorpio Sun opposes Taurus Sun. The Full Moon. These signs are total opposites, so resolve and stubbornness can be an issue. So can flirting with excesses of any kind. That said, there is no surprise to see the opposition at 8:48 between Moon and Mercury (in Taurus). This would not be a good first date day--or a time to stage a challenge. By the lunch hour, Taurus Sun conjuncts with Mercury (in Taurus). Emotionally, something that needed stabilizing has been announced. Moon may not be so happy because at 2:20, Scorpio Moon squares

with Mars (in Leo). Watch for severe storms where Low Pressure prevails, and tempers in some people. At 7:01, Ceres (in Virgo) goes into retrograde. There's another hint that we will be reworking family and home/land issues for several months. (Think of the Arizona immigration bill. We close with the 8:38, Venus (in Gemini) quincunx with Ceres (in Capricorn). Again, relationships and priorities need restructuring. If you ignore this period and find comfort in denial, you have no one to blame but yourself at what can/may occur hereafter. Bad or unpleasant situations are opportunities for change. Don't let them pass unheeded.

Thursday, the 29th is slow to start, a hint at the magnitude of weighty energy in the atmosphere. At 9:32 a.m. EDT, Venus (in Gemini) forms another quincunx this time with Pluto (in Capricorn). That's the end of something or someone. At 11:04, Scorpio Moon trines with Jupiter (in Pisces). While moisture is on the increase where Low Pressure advances, good fortune backs some in need of a guardian angel. At 7:48 p.m. EDT, Moon squares with Neptune (in Aquarius) rejecting the sugar coating to some ideas. By 8:07, Moon sextiles with Saturn (in Virgo). Law and boundaries are respected. In just over a half hour, Moon trines with Uranus (in Pisces). Watch for sudden downpours/storms, or surprises in some people's actions/behavior. At 10:36, Moon enters Sagittarius. By 11:16, Moon wastes no time to square with Chiron (in Pisces). Someone--perhaps intending mischief--is not taking no for an answer.

Friday, the 30th slows down a bit with only four aspects beginning with the 10:23, Sagittarius Moon opposition to Venus (in Gemini). What was said that works against funding and relationships? First think "perspective" before you speak. At 11:13, Moon forms a quincunx with Mercury (in Taurus). Choose your words carefully today. At 5:26 p.m. EDT, Moon does the same with Taurus Sun. You're not going to budge or tease someone resolute, so quit before things go too far. The 9:17, Moon trines with Mars (in Leo) indicating someone didn't listen. This is triple Fire energy. Expect news of volcanic activity, an attack, or something equally explosive.

Saturday, the 1st of May brings only one aspect and that is the Sagittarius square with Jupiter (in Pisces). There is little/no luck for some.

Sunday, 2nd gets busy again starting with the 3:05 a.m. EDT, Sagittarius Moon sextile with Neptune (in Aquarius). Some behavior is in the wind that is not totally on the up and up. Rules and law are in danger of being broken--watch the Moon square with Saturn (in Virgo). In an hour Moon then squares with Uranus (in Pisces). Moon moves into Capricorn by 6:00 a.m. Within the hour, Capricorn Moon sextiles with Chiron (in Pisces). At 7:48 p.m. EDT, Moon conjuncts with Ceres (also in Capricorn)--but don't forget Ceres is in retrograde. At 4:04, Moon conjuncts again, this time with Pluto (also in Capricorn). It's 4:46 when Moon trines with Mercury (in Taurus). At 8:22, Saturn (in Virgo) forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius). Beginning and ending with the Neptune maneuver doesn't speak well for being forthcoming and helpful. Where relationships have a history of trouble, watch your back--and keep in touch with those you love.
