

## Planetary Forecast November 1-7, 2010

*In review...*you didn't have to read beyond the *This Week* paragraph to understand that Mars energy claimed most of the headlines. The twisted and most indoctrinated among us reflected Mars (in Sagittarius) in the worst way and by Friday we were alerted to UPS packages from Yemen found in Dubai and the U.K. that contained explosives hidden in printer toner cartridges. So far a female Yemeni medical student has been apprehended, and more arrests will undoubtedly follow. Added to this is a week's worth of mysterious shootings at military institutions and memorials in the D.C.-Va. area.

*This week...* it's action and messages/statements, even if some of what occurs will pass under the radar of most folks. Mars will get entangled with Virgo Moon first and that's all about the payoff or punishment in regards to paying attention (or not) to details. Venus will also leave Scorpio (remember she's in retrograde) and re-enter Libra, which is where she's happiest, except that in this environment we may be reviewing cash outlays more than romances. With Pluto also a big presence this week, we shall see some causing their own undoing and that certainly should speak to political rises and falls, but who else? Don't forget that Neptune also ends its long retrograde (but remains in Aquarius for a while) and consensus has it that this brings more empathy and compassion. Perhaps in the best of all worlds, but for politicians, this is also their way of spinning things to avoid being truthful. And for those states/areas still enjoying Daylight Savings, this is your last week before we return to Standard Time.

*Monday*, November 1st starts with the 4:45 a.m. EDT, Virgo Moon square with Mars (in Sagittarius). This is followed by the 5:30, Moon trine with Pluto (in Capricorn). Something smelled rotten in the details, says Moon and Pluto ushers out the who or what to the nearest exit. Within ten minutes, Moon then sextiles with Venus (in Scorpio). In an attempt to appease angry voters, will the White House announce the Bush tax cuts are continuing? Then at 9:37, Venus sextiles Pluto. It doesn't appear that everyone will be happy with whatever occurs. At 11:36, Moon trines with Ceres (in Capricorn). This is women and families taking a stand for stability and responsibility. The last aspect is at 3:16 p.m. EDT when Moon sextiles with Scorpio Sun. Analysis and attention to details are humming along. Use the day for making big strides in projects that need your full focus.

*Tuesday* the 2nd and Election Day starts with the 9:18 a.m. EDT, Virgo Moon sextile in Mercury (in Scorpio). The message is "facts and the bottom line." It's 3:24 p.m. EDT, when Moon opposes Jupiter (in Pisces). Whether it's the White House running out of luck or the public refusing to listen to empty rhetoric, the results seem to be the same. However, don't think for a moment that those who see and treat the public like Bart Simpson believe their agenda is on the skids--so says the 6:39 p.m. EDT, Moon quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius) indicating the desire of some to super glue those rose-colored glasses onto your faces. As always in 15 minutes, Moon also forms a quincunx with Chiron (again in Aquarius), the second spiel of this milquetoast formation to try and convince us that we deserve to be taken care of because we are victims of big business and bad government. At 8:36, Moon opposes Uranus (in

Pisces). This could speak to polling place behavior or the public rejection of ballots that another "ACORN" tainted group was hired to monitor and keep honest, which is shades of the pit viper being asked to guard a baby chick incubator.

*Wednesday*, the 3rd and we begin early with the 1:19 a.m. EDT, Moon shift into Libra. Libra is usually the sign for diplomacy and eloquence, but things could get sticky today when at 6:54, Libra Moon squares with Pluto (in Capricorn). That sounds like a rejection of what the elections indicate. Are recounts underway, as well? At 8:38, Moon then sextiles with Mars (in Sagittarius). Expect no congratulations to the winners of yesterday's contests, or no acceptance that some policy is dead. By 1:55 p.m. EDT, Moon then squares with Ceres (also in Capricorn) indicating the very sign that embraces beauty and life is sticking it to women and the family. Repairs are attempted with the last aspect of the day, the 8:34 p.m. EDT, Moon conjunction with Saturn (in Libra) when Moon agrees to obey the law. At least some should accept what the voters have proclaimed.

*Thursday*, the 4th takes a good while to get into gear--it's 4:09 p.m. EDT before Libra Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Pisces). That's followed at 5:46 when Mercury (in Scorpio) trines with Jupiter. Some may be the recipients of benevolence or plain good luck. At 7:34, Moon trines with Neptune (in Aquarius) followed in twelve minutes with the same trine with Chiron (again in Aquarius). Then we end with the 9:27, Moon quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). Something doesn't "smell" right here because you shouldn't need to pretend and try to pull a fast one if you are on the right side of ethics and the law. The "who and what" in this case will tell us a great deal.

*Friday*, the 5th and New Moon time, but first Moon enters Scorpio at 2:16 a.m. EDT. At 4:24, Scorpio Moon conjuncts with Venus (in Scorpio). With this intensity of water energy, expect precipitation momentum to be on the fast increase and emotions or tension to be on the rise. At 4:24, Scorpio Moon conjuncts with Venus (in Scorpio) and that's about passion and perhaps some good financial news for some. At 7:59, Moon then sextiles with Pluto (in Capricorn) a friendly planet to Scorpio and the endings we see should not be surprises, rather necessary. At 2:42 p.m. EDT, Chiron goes direct and maybe the wine game is coming to an end and the hero will begin emerging at last. At 4:09 Moon sextiles with Ceres (also in Capricorn) supporting women and family stability.

*Saturday*, the 6th continues with the New Moon momentum depending on where you are on the planet. On the east coast at 12:52, Scorpio Moon conjuncts with Scorpio Sun. That's a good deal of water energy and, therefore, those in the path of Low Pressure (perhaps the next tropical storm/hurricane) take heed. At 2:44, Mercury (also in Scorpio) squares with Neptune (in Aquarius). At 5:11, Mercury then does the same with Chiron (also in Aquarius). Here again is a rejection of euphemisms and hiding the truth and facts. It's 5:47 p.m. EDT, when Moon trines with Jupiter (in Pisces) suggesting success at the shedding of light on matters for the reason of transparency. At 8:15, Mercury also trines with Uranus (in Pisces). Thunderstorms could be on the increase and/or an abrupt resignation. Watch for repercussions at 9:29 and 9:45 when Moon squares with first Neptune and then Chiron. Again, the rejection of business as usual and a respect for fiscal responsibility is the electorate's demand. Then at 11:22, Moon

trines with Uranus. We end at 11:44 when Moon conjuncts with Mercury. Message delivered. The public demands those they elect to stop the waste and govern with common sense.

*Sunday*, the 7th and we come to the end of Daylight Savings at 2 a.m. EDT. Just before that (1:04 a.m.) Neptune went direct. So now by 3:28, Moon will shift into Sagittarius and that's it until the late afternoon when at 4:43 p.m. EST (yes, we're back to Standard Time), Sagittarius Moon will conjunct with Mars (also in Sagittarius). Watch for the crazy-makers and the diehard radicals to pull something because they can and because some refuse to "see" anyone's perspective but their own. At 10:06, Venus backs into Libra.
