

Planetary Forecast November 14-20, 2011

In review, it was a shocking week as Neptune went direct and we took off those rose-colored glasses and faced reality. With that, Penn State faced upheaval with the news that long-time football coach Sandusky was arrested on sexual assault charges, the president was fired, as was head coach Joe Paterno. In addition, as Italy faces austerity votes/problems, Prime Minister Berlusconi resigns, and Michael Jackson's doctor is found guilty of wrongful death.

*This week...*we deal with the conflict between Uranus and Pluto--something that has been happening on and off since April when we had Brazilian school massacres, the Dutch mall shootings, synagogue pipe bombings, Thailand-Cambodia clashes, and Middle East woes. Domestic crime was also up sharply with home invasions and children being murdered in parental power plays. Storms were also harsher and cost lives. Forewarned, there is time to take precautions!

As Sun continues its final last full week in Scorpio, we'll be dealing with Moon in fellow water sign Cancer, Leo, Virgo, and finally Libra. That's water, fire, earth, and air energies. The early part of the week could bring strong storms or flooding where low pressure prevails. As things dry out, watch for fire and assaults. By Sunday we'll start with three squares and they're all about communication--or in this case miscommunication. Take care not to jump to the wrong conclusion, or at least try and see if something can be worked out. On the other hand, don't let someone try to bamboozle you into believing something that is pure nonsense or lies.

Monday, November 14th begins with Moon shifting into Cancer at 2:19 a.m. EST. This is a fruitful and wet period--great for autumn gardening, but otherwise carry a raincoat and umbrella. Your intuition will be reliable, your dreams active, but put another filter on the voice box and wear a sweater if you can't grow thicker skin overnight. The thing is that here Moon will be a tad emotional, and considering your spiritual path, some might be ultra sensitive where they have little or no cause to be. At 3:34, Cancer Moon will trine with Chiron in (Pisces). What did I tell you? Step back, take a deep breath, and count to 50 before acting on something said or inferred. Otherwise, it is going to be a wet, wet day, and increasingly stormy what with Uranus (in Aries) squaring with Moon by 4:06. If it's not about the weather, it's about someone jumping to maybe the wrong conclusion and being too quick on the trigger finger. Was that really smart or fair? I can see some won't pay attention because at 5:28, Moon then sextiles with Aries (in Virgo) and feels justified in a rabid response. On the other hand, this afternoon brings good luck and creativity what with the 8:22, Moon sextile with Jupiter (in Taurus). But at 1:26 p.m. EST, we end with Moon then opposing Pluto (in Capricorn). Moon is behaving like Bridget Jones insisting you love her, "Just the way she is." I have known a few crabs with that perspective and if that is possible, fine. But if you are bloodied and weary of acting like a mental and physical contortionist trying to keep things mellow, here's an opportunity to wish them a good life and move on.

Tuesday, the 15th brings a calmer day with only three aspects. At 7:49 a.m. EST, Cancer Moon forms a quincunx with Mercury (in Sagittarius). Ahem. Water and Fire could be playing with claws and matches. Both sides will tell their friends or

anyone else who will listen, "I was only kidding. What's he/she getting all upset over?" Take care not to start something that could end badly. But at 9:54, Moon does the same thing with Venus (also in Sagittarius). That's now pokes or slashes at the heart or wallet. We'll end with the 11:03 p.m. EST, Moon trine with Scorpio Sun. This is double water energy and we could be looking at strong precipitation where Low Pressure advances. Otherwise, ESP and dreams are at a high point, but don't expect Scorpio to fight Cancer's battles without serious proof that it's warranted.

Wednesday, the 16th starts with the 12:22 a.m. EST, Cancer Moon square with Saturn (in Libra). Moon didn't heed Sun's advice and is breaking a law/boundary/lesson. This is unfortunate, but it's not like Moon wasn't warned. Who doesn't want to play by the rules or respect principle? By 7:51, Moon is trying "spin" as it forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius). All of the adults have permission to leave the room and continue with work as planned. It's not like Moon will admit her mistake/misstep, and there's much to do. At 11:17, Moon shifts into Leo. We go from water energy to fire, so as things dry up as Low Pressure moves on, we also have our over-sensitivity or even our compassion-empathy turning into ego-driven focus. Use this period for getting a lot done and being enthusiastic and supportive, but while honing leadership skills, watch for over-confidence. A 12:50 p.m. EST, Leo Moon will quincunx Chiron (in Pisces), and before the hour is up trine with Uranus (in Aries) another fire sign. Watch for the tendency to play victim, or indulge in any backhandedness. At 4:33, Moon squares with Jupiter (in Taurus), indicating if something less than legal was attempted--or unfair--it's going to be exposed. At 5:08, Mars (in Virgo) trines with Jupiter. Mars is about detail here. Still be careful that if you're trying to achieve something that it's ethical and safe. AT 10:01, we end with the Moon quincunx with Pluto (in Capricorn). Remember that this is a seven day in Numerology and carries a spiritual tone. Take the high ground where possible, pray for luck and benevolence, and do watch out for those dark souls with agendas.

Thursday, the 17th brings only two aspects and it's a far more positive day. At 7:08 p.m. EST, Leo Moon trines with Mercury (in Sagittarius) and at 10:59, Moon trines with Venus (also in Sagittarius). With all this fire energy, messages and conversations will be fluid. Take care not to be put off/out by the ego-driven individual. We can mentally step around them and go on achieving what we need to progress-wise. Suggestion: a little humility can go a long way.

Friday, the 18th gets busy again beginning with the 7:28 a.m. EST, Leo Moon sextile with Saturn (in Libra). We're ad hearing to law and borders, and hard-earned lessons. But at 10:09, Moon squares with Scorpio Sun. This is the end of the moon's third quarter. It's time to reorganize and prepare for new projects. Finish up with what's still needing last minute tweaks. At 2:05 p.m. EST, Leo Moon opposes Neptune (in Aquarius). While Moon is usually compatible with Aquarius and not shy about exaggerating or at least enhancing something for her own benefit, here it pays to stick to facts. After all Moon is weakening and we're about to move into Virgo, who can easily undo all of Leo Moon's progress, so accomplishments should be substantive, not self-serving. At 5:19, Moon does move into Virgo. Don't look for a lot of precipitation yet, but focus on catching up on paperwork and other projects before the holidays slow

us down with entertaining and trips. At 6:29, Moon opposes Chiron (in Pisces), which is another way to say, "Quit whining and get to work." Before the hour is out, Moon also forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Aries), and hopefully that is when we're getting last minute approval for something, and/or funding. We close with the 9:50 Moon trine with Jupiter (in Taurus). It's a good evening to buy a lottery ticket or--if you've been paying attention--save yourself some costly error/mistake. Enjoy the evening with friends and other loved ones to regroup.

Saturday, the 19th brings only two aspects, the 12:12 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon conjunction with Mars (also in Virgo) and the 3:32, Moon trine with Pluto (in Capricorn). This is about progress and transformation. What was announced this weekend and who is either transitioning into a new position or ending a campaign? Tomorrow will be problematic as the message gets twisted, or there are gaffs, but stay on schedule and message where possible. Things could/should still work out.

Sunday, the 20th brings a series of two squares for Virgo Moon starting at 1:51 a.m. EST, when Moon squares with Mercury (in Sagittarius). At 7:54, Moon does the same with Venus (also in Sagittarius), and by 3:42, Scorpio Sun does the same with Neptune (in Aquarius). What is going on here? There's been a blunder of some sort, or another scandal, and financial backing is going to dry up fast. There could be counter charges/allegations, but Scorpio sun tells Neptune to quit the theatrics. By 5:21 late that afternoon, Virgo Moon and Scorpio Sun are harmonious/on the same page as they sextile. We're back on solid ground in time for Moon to shift to Libra at 8:16. Negotiations get help. By 9:25, Libra Moon will try to urge Chiron (in Pisces and via a quincunx) to cooperate and take the high ground. We'll end with more meetings and dialoguing and diplomacy from Moon as it opposes Uranus (in Aries) in an attempt to stop any attacks or continued opposition. Will that work? It's not looking entirely successful, but we're entering Thanksgiving week and Sagittarius Sun, who wants to just sit and visit a while and play/party.
