

Planetary Forecast for November 9-15, 2009

In review... while much occurred this week, we'll focus on only two events because they effected the greatest number of lives and provide the most profound and poignant lessons. Chiron did play a pity-party/victim card not only when Major Nidel Malik Hasan opened fire on fellow soldiers at Ft. Hood, Texas, but an ex-employee at an Orlando, Florida engineering firm did the same. In Hasan's case, we also see the Gemini Moon illuminating the "*Et tu, Brutus*" momentum--in this case where the Army psychiatrist, who should have been among the most trusted confidants and advisors, became one of the most dreaded and despicable. Also remember that I warned last month when Sun transitioned into Scorpio a momentum for deep-seated anger would intensify in some. Scorpio and its prime planet Pluto deal with our deepest and darkest issues. We can use that to better understand life and our place in the universe and emerge like the Phoenix reincarnated, better equipped to survive and serve, or we can dive head first into, and embrace, all that is destructive and evil. We also saw Chiron at its most heroic as displayed by many, some wounded themselves, striving to save others. As I wrote, history would allow us to understand more clearly. We were given perfect examples of how an aspect does not *force* you to behave in a certain way, the atmosphere gives you the opportunity to reach for the best or worst in yourself.

This week... Monday, November 9th will start another active and highly emotional week beginning with the 12:34 a.m. EST, Venus (in Scorpio) sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn). It's going to be difficult to make progress when rascals and renegades are marauding the landscape and raiding our wallets. It also doesn't help that with the active Fire energy, we can have situations popping up faster than we can physically and intellectually deal with them. Emotions will be tested. Strive to keep to the high ground and stay connected with your sense of humor. At 2:01, Leo Moon then squares with Ceres (in Scorpio). This is not good news for families, particularly women and children. Storms could be a problem where tropical systems advance, and raids could be brutal. The last aspect of the morning is the 10:58, Leo Moon-Scorpio Sun square as Moon completes its third quarter and represents the "culmination" of plans--as last week also showed us. (Including the late Saturday night's vote/passing of the healthcare bill in the House of Representatives). Aside from some testy conversations and stand-offs, have additional respect for lightning and when dealing with electricity. This is an atmosphere where electrocutions and power losses are above average. At 12:41 p.m. EST, Moon then opposes Jupiter (in Aquarius). This isn't a lucky period and last week's and this morning's behavior and activities will not win friends or support in funding. At 3:57, Moon squares with Mercury (also in Scorpio) and that is the message being delivered. Bitterness prevails and conversations could get explosive. At 5:34, Moon opposes Chiron (in Aquarius), and at 8:21, Moon forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). This is troubling as reckless and relentless Moon is determined to have its way and there is little "heroics" involved. Assume nothing when it comes to your safety and well-being. At 9:43, Moon opposes Neptune (in Aquarius). This is another sign that few are interested in trying for the pretty spin on their agenda. The lion smells fresh blood and is charging for the feast.

Tuesday, the 10th will launch with the 8:19 a.m. EST, Mercury (in Scorpio) square with Chiron (in Aquarius). Clashes and power struggles continue. The call is out for the weak or apathetic to find their backbone and not succumb to being turned into a number, or a means to an end on so many levels. Moon enters Virgo at 8:30, which is more help to Scorpio Sun. At 11:11 EST, Virgo Moon then trines with Pluto (in Capricorn). Something/Someone ends or a relationship/agreement/treaty is blocked due to strategic details/data. This double Earth energy could speak to strong earthquakes, as well. At 1:47 p.m. EST, Scorpio Sun then squares with Jupiter (in Aquarius). This is a harsh response to previous conduct and no extended hand for bygones being bygones. We'll end at 2:31 with Virgo Moon in sextile with Venus (in Scorpio). While personal

relationships should fare better, and some detail/delayed funding is cut loose, any sense of harmony is short-lived.

Wednesday the 11th and it's Veterans Day. At 6:38 a.m. EST, Mercury (in Scorpio) will trine with Uranus (in Pisces). This double Water energy brings increased moisture where Low Pressure advances--watch for the storm currently entering the Gulf of Mexico. Otherwise, expect to hear announcements that surprise and signal what is occurring will not be easily forgotten. At 7:05, Virgo Moon then sextiles with Chiron (in Scorpio). This is empowering energy for women and families. At 4:34 p.m. EST, Moon forms a quincunx with Jupiter (in Aquarius). Some outside-of-the-box thinking may be needed today. Unfortunately, we may hear of new funding for some/something because it's politically advantageous. By 6:29, Virgo Moon sextiles with Scorpio Sun as the Fourth Quarter commences. It's time to clear the desk, paper-shred ideas and projects that aren't working, and prepare to start over...only not until after the New Moon. Not surprisingly, at 7:11, Mercury (in Scorpio) will square with Neptune (in Aquarius). This is a harsh statement on the consensus thus far. Echoing/supporting that idea is the 9:13, Moon quincunx with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 11:57, we end with Moon's opposition to Uranus (in Pisces). Surprises are not welcome and neither is continued spending. Since we are on a higher alert, any attempts at attacks should be met with strong repression.

Thursday, the 12th will start with a 1:25 a.m. EST, Virgo Moon quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius), followed by a 2:13, Moon sextile with Mercury (in Scorpio). Offenses on Wednesday will be responded to with censure and retribution today. At 12:22 p.m. EST, Moon shifts into Libra to help make the comments memorable, although what weight they carry depends on the who, what and why. At 2:53, Libra Moon conjuncts with Saturn (also in Libra). This double Air rhetoric is an assurance and promise of respecting law and lessons; however, we end with the 3:12, Moon square with Pluto (in Capricorn) and this clash of Air and Earth indicates lip service has been paid and we'll rue this day in the future--perhaps a not too distant one.

Friday, the 13th and we're limited to three aspects starting with the 8:40 a.m. EST, Scorpio Sun square with Chiron (in Aquarius). Water and Air are not communicating well and Sun has no interest in hearing from whiners and self-described victims. At 9:51, Libra Moon then sextiles with Mars (in Leo). This is a highly unusual position for this moon, and the Air-Fire energy here could mean a surprise move logistically or behind-the-scenes rather than a military attack. It could well be successful for it's speed--so says the Moon trine with Jupiter at 9:28 p.m. EST.

Saturday the 14th and the atmosphere grows more complicated and frustrating. At 1:54 a.m. EST, Libra Moon trines with Chiron (in Aquarius). At 4:35, Moon then forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). Then there's the 6:10, Moon trine with Neptune (in Aquarius) indicates the truth may be stretched to its limits for actions taken/comments made. At 5:24 p.m. EST, Moon shifts over into Scorpio and things intensify again since this puts us in both Scorpio Moon *and* Sun. We're dealing with double Water energy, so expect precipitation to be considerable where Low Pressure prevails and analysis to be painfully on point. By 8:26, Scorpio Moon will sextile with Pluto (in Capricorn). This doesn't bode well for those who have been testing others patience, also watch for accidents related to bridges, dams, etc. Remember we had a Water-Earth situation going on when those three college girls from North Dakota drove into a pond with their Jeep and drowned last week. In twenty minutes, we close with the Scorpio Sun trine with Uranus (in Pisces). Since Pluto looms again, along with an extremely disturbing square with the Lesson Master as we enter Sunday, it would be wise to take every precaution with safety, while traveling, and dealing with individuals who you know have given you reason to doubt them. Military-wise, the power plays continue and could get extra ugly.

Sunday, the 15th is slow to start due to yesterday's actions that could have many, even an

entire nation once again reeling. At 10:20 a.m. EST, Saturn (in Libra) then squares with Pluto (in Capricorn). What boundary or law has been trampled? In twenty-one minutes, Scorpio Moon then conjuncts with Venus (in Scorpio). Double Water energy brings intuition, analysis, and funding into play. At 5:03 p.m. EST, Moon then squares with Mars (in Leo) and that Water-Air clash could be storms or a mighty political/military battle. At 6:11, Moon then squares with Neptune (in Aquarius). This is a protest against lies or intentional deception. But at 7:28, Mercury is shifting into Fire sign Sagittarius and like Gemini, the baser souls here will play crazy makers and gremlins because that's entertaining and they are in control of the steering wheel for the moment. Understand that their full comprehension of what's at stake is minimal. That doesn't excuse the situation, but don't expect to make them face that reality for long, either. At 8:49, Moon then conjuncts with Ceres (also in Scorpio). All is not lost due to the sheer stamina of good soldiers and other strong, stabilizing efforts. Bottom line--don't look for a great deal of tact or common sense in the few weeks. Considering that more people are losing jobs, property taxes are coming due, as well as federal quarterly taxes, and Christmas pressures are upon us, we could see an increase rather than a decrease of crime. Be safe, make moments count, and practice economy in all things except hugs.
