

Planetary Forecast for September 10-16, 2007

*In review...*Monday's warning of difficult Fire-Earth energy did bring the dreaded "anger" and "serious accidents" momentum. Re anger, a promising band member in Dallas was shot to death after a drunken brawl with his girlfriend. He'd become disorientated and tried to break into a neighbor's home. As for the serious accidents concern, adventurer and self-made millionaire Steve Fossett's single-engine plane has gone missing in West Nevada. As of Sunday, searchers have found no sign of him or the plane. In addition, a small plane crashed into Lake Erie and a rower was able to rescue one young boy. Sadly, the other two persons on-board were killed. During an air show practice flight in Virginia, a pilot also died in a crash. Then on Saturday an Air Force Huey helicopter crashed in Florida during a special ops training flight; thankfully, while two are injured, another five servicemen could walk away from the wreckage.

The threat of terrorism widens and intensifies with this energy. In Denmark, eight Muslims were arrested for being in possession of bomb-making material, and in Frankfurt, Germany three are arrested for a bombing plot on the airport and two U.S. airbases. Up to fifty additional suspects are being sought in this plan that was in its eleventh hour. Not good news as 9/11 looms and unique planetary formations continue. The Neptune impulse to "deny-deny-deny" or "lie outright" was illustrated by the Senator Craig situation wherein the political figure now is considering recanting his promise to resign. Environmental problems did increase on Wednesday as forecasted--Mt. Etna erupted with a fiery geyser for over an hour, while Taipei, Taiwan experienced a 6.6 earthquake. As for celebrity losses, the music world said goodbye to a beloved voice; Luciano Pavarotti died at the age of 71 from pancreatic cancer. Yes, Pluto was opposing Gemini Moon. Pluto announcing it was silencing one of the communication sign's brilliant tenors and showmen. And as of Sunday with Pluto in quincunx with Cancer Moon, Afghan's President Karzai has survived/escaped yet another assassination attempt.

*This week...*Monday the 10th will have only two aspects, which is welcome after a busy Sunday and the looming September 11th anniversary. First, at 1:36 p.m. EDT, Venus (in Leo) forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces)--the length of time between the last Sunday aspect and this one is something to keep an eye on. Then there's another six hour pause when at 7:46, Virgo Moon squares with Jupiter (in Sagittarius). It would be wholly understandable to feel impulsive about those things that effect us the most (whether it's a relationship, a job, a plan, or a thing that doesn't "give" when we "push, prod, pry, or twist" with all our energy and focus). The cosmic advice is to resist and stop throwing away good money/energy after bad, burning up the phone or internet lines on useless causes, and to find something actually *constructive* to do with our time. To borrow from John Donne's poem, tomorrow's solar eclipse tolls a bell demanding that we change, adapt, and grow for the future. Either be graceful about it, or prepare to deal with this kind of frustration, hurt, or pain again--and repeatedly.

Tuesday, the 11th and all the world will be alert as we deal with 9/11, New Moon, and the Solar Eclipse. The day's aspects begin with the 5:17 a.m. EDT, Virgo Moon opposition with Uranus (in Pisces), which is a clear attempt to squash radical behavior and avoid costly sabotage. At 8:44 Virgo Moon then conjuncts with Virgo Sun., meaning we're in solid and stolid Earth energy and keeping our eyes out for trouble, yet keeping everything else functioning reasonably well. At 11:37 Moon then forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius) in an emotional--though perhaps not logical or healthy attempt to force an issue; this could be a suicide bomber issue gone awry, a series of bomb threats at airports--some due to copycat, celebrity-seekers, or some other "stuff" cluttering the systems. At 2:31 p.m. EDT, Moon squares with Mars (in Gemini), another Earth and Air clash, this time involving more anger/violence. Aside from a bomb concern, a volcanic

eruption cannot be discounted. Also note that how successful troublemakers are depends on being alert and following our instincts and intuitive skills well, for there is a Grand Cross coming on the 13th between Sun, Mars, Jupiter, Uranus, and Pluto, which will compound the necessity to keep vigilant and reason with a clear head.

Wednesday, the 12th begins with the 12:14 a.m. EDT, Virgo Moon square with Pluto (in Sagittarius), which is an Earth-Fire blow. Watch the news reports for overseas pertaining to U.S. or ally resources. At 7:31 Moon shifts to Libra, generally seen as a time of rejuvenating the spirit and enjoying more pleasurable interests; right now that would be a mistake, and understandably, at 8:21 p.m. EDT, Virgo Sun forms a quincunx with Neptune (in Aquarius) in a rejection of fuzzy thinking and wild ideas. How this plays out on the political arena is anyone's guess, but let's just put this out there...to vote for/side with failure on a military front for the sake of winning an election is national suicide.

Thursday the 13th, Rosh Hashanah and Ramadan begin, and also a Mutable Grand Cross occurs, meaning four or five planets (in this case five) form 90 degree angles. So we have Sun, Mars, Jupiter, Uranus, and Pluto in the strongest of formations outside of an eclipse. In addition, at 6:43 a.m. EDT, Mercury (in Libra) sextiles with Jupiter (in Sagittarius). At 7:23, Libra Moon sextiles with Jupiter. In five minutes Libra Moon conjuncts with Mercury. At 4:30 p.m. EDT, Moon forms a quincunx with Uranus (in Pisces). At 5:37 Moon, sextiles with Venus (in Leo). At 11:06 p.m., Moon trines with Neptune (in Aquarius). This is a communications and highly political day. Talk is cheap and we'll need disinfectant soap to wash away the poison and excessive fructose by day's end. It will take many deep breaths to remember to focus on our journey and to reach for higher ideals. By all means, though, extend the hand of compassion wherever it's possible.

Friday the 14th begins with the 5:00 a.m. EDT trine between Libra Moon and Mars (in Gemini). At 12:10 p.m. EDT, Moon sextiles with Pluto (in Sagittarius). At 7:37 Moon enters Scorpio. At 10:46 Scorpio Moon sextiles with Saturn (in Virgo). This is like the infantry support coming before a total massacre. Continue with work in progress and don't let the "dogs of war" feed on vulnerable feelings. There are many benefits of patience and these are one of those times.

Saturday the 15th and are you ready...? No major aspects today. In all the time that I've been following planetary movements, I've never seen this occur. See this as a gift and use the time to embrace family, friends, and to all-around regroup.

Sunday, the 16th starts at 4:56 a.m. EDT when Scorpio Moon trines with Uranus (in Pisces) bringing double Water energy to cause either a hefty flooding momentum somewhere where a Low exists or a highly emotional moment. At 7:31 Moon squares with Venus (in Leo) which is a rejection of the superficial and idolatry of the tangible. At 10:59, Mercury (in Libra) forms a quincunx with Uranus with another blast of harsh "communication" (and expect anything from words to weapons). At 11:41 Moon squares with Neptune in a rejection of one-sided logic/lies. At 7:40 p.m., EDT, Scorpio Moon sextiles with Virgo Sun holding the line for discipline and patient and fair judgment. We end at 8:32 with the Moon quincunx with Mars (in Gemini). No surprise. There is an endless army of jackals who have no purpose but to defeat what they don't want to succeed.
