

Planetary Forecast for September 24-30, 2007

In review... it wasn't wise to leave "fools to their folly" this week, as proven by Nebraska senator, Ernie Chambers, who chose to file suit against God for natural disasters. (His logic being to draw attention to excessive lawsuits.) Yes, really. Then there was the MIT student who entered Boston's Logan International Airport with a fake bomb taped to her T-shirt. As for the anger, and back-stabbing threat, there were numerous incidents of violence and revenge, beginning in China where a man invited dozens of his townspeople to dinner to "make peace" over a disagreement--and proceeded to blow up the restaurant. Nine are dead and twenty-five are injured. In fact the methods of the "gotcha" individuals were particularly cruel and gruesome this week, most too distasteful and horrific to detail. The least offensive is the shooting of two students on the Delaware State University campus. Plenty of Fire energy did yield numerous fires, explosions, and accidents that triggered infernos. Finally, one of the more disgusting results of this period of increased lies and deception and evil intent brought one positive result--in Florida a *U.S. Prosecutor* was nabbed in an online sting operation when he attempted to make a deal for sex with an undercover cop (posing as a mother) to sell her *five year old child*. As I warned, it was a week when the stupid, crazy, and soulless seemed to be in control of our streets and air waves.

This week... Monday the 24th. the second day of Autumn, begins with a 2:23 a.m. EDT, Aquarius Moon trine with Mercury in Libra. Expect radicals and outlaws in particular to be full of hyperbole. Then at 2:45, Moon then sextiles with Pluto (in Sagittarius), so don't be surprised if there are some repercussions to some comments. It's 5:14 when Moon trines with Mars (in Gemini) hinting at more and more mischief and rabblousing. For the rest of us, try to use this period for eloquent communication and fluid writing. At 6:55 Moon shifts into Pisces--for some a time for wise reflection and some psychic insight. But watch for underhandedness by the mean spirited. At 10:55, Pisces Moon forms a quincunx with Libra Sun, and if we're feeling a little vulnerable, face the reason(s) why and commit to making changes. The final aspect of the day is a 1:30 p.m. EDT, Moon opposition with Saturn (in Virgo). Pisces Moon is a period when we're least appreciative of boundaries and rules; nevertheless, they're there for a reason, so try to be respectful and avoid whining too much. Few are in the mood to listen.

Tuesday, the 25th launches with a 7:24 a.m. EDT, Pisces Moon square with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) and that's a limitation of luck and resources for those thinking they've earned a right or reward. The hard Water-Fire square will also make weather an issue to be dealt with in areas where a Low Pressure System lingers. At 11:44, Moon conjuncts with Uranus (also in Pisces) and that means expect the unexpected; we're talking calamity, recklessness, flooding, and the costly results thereof. Lastly, at 9:01 p.m. EDT, Moon forms a quincunx with Venus (in Leo) making it difficult to have a romantic night. Moodiness or rebukes are more likely. A deeper sense of the moment-situation-individual is required--or the recognition that something is more trouble than it is worth.

Wednesday, the 26th and time for another Full Moon. First, however, is the 4:33 a.m. EDT, Pisces Moon square with Pluto (in Sagittarius); that feels of tricky maneuvering and fateful domino stuff. We've had plenty of warnings with this moon. Otherwise, expect the "crazies" to be out and about making it a busy night for law enforcement and hospitals. At 8:17 Moon then forms a quincunx with Mercury (at home in Gemini) putting our feelings into words. At 8:31 Moon squares with Mars (also in Gemini) for a throw the gauntlet attitude. At the very least, expect stress and challenges, some depression for others. Autumn is beloved by many, but feared-dreaded by those who need sunshine and warmth and hate being housebound. A check-in to seniors and a promise for an Indian Summer drive could help. At 10:22 Moon enters Aries, which should give our energy a boost. At

1:53 p.m. EDT, Mercury (in Libra) trines with Mars (in Gemini) giving us the enthusiasm and eloquence in communications--but watch for those with dangerous agendas; there "messages" might be less welcome. At 3:07, Aries Moon forms a quincunx with Saturn (in Virgo). See what I mean? At 3:45 we have the final aspect, Full Moon, as Aries Moon opposes Libra Sun. Fire and Air, both in Cardinal signs aren't harshly lashing out, but are in a long-term, serious push-pull for power. Expect some fires either environmental or spawned by temper and accidents.

Thursday the 27th finds us with an 8:23 a.m. EDT, Aries Moon trine with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) creating double Fire energy which is excellent for projects and inspiration, but worrisome for tempers especially for those not in control of their mood swings. At 1:17 p.m. EDT, Mercury enters Scorpio; therefore, expect frank, and succinct communications., and more intuitive perception, which should help us with the moody ones. At 5:39, Aries Moon sextiles with Neptune (in Aquarius) indicating someone may take that opportunity to pull the wool over someone else's eyes...or many eyes. We have the vision to avoid that from happening. At 11:03, Moon trines with Venus (in Leo) suggesting when one well-meaning attempt fails, try another, this time using charm, but watch it when it comes from someone with an agenda who doesn't have your best interests in mind.

Friday the 28th will begin with the 4:34 a.m. EDT, Aries Moon trine with Pluto (in Sagittarius), that's double Fire energy and destiny-driven Pluto? Take the day off if you can. While this could mean a job offer or some commitment that's welcome and holds great opportunity, for others it could bode serious if not fatal trouble. At 9:58, Moon sextiles with Mars (in Gemini). That's Mars' home sign and suggests there's no stopping determined Aries. Watch for recklessness and willfulness. We may be hearing disturbing news nationally and internationally. At 10:17 Moon shifts into Taurus, which should bring a more stabilizing atmosphere, although it will take a few hours. At 11:49, Taurus Moon opposes Mercury (in Scorpio), indicating a stubborn rejection of someone's plea or warning. At 3:21, Moon trines with Saturn (in Virgo) and that's either determination to hold to a lesson--but whose? At 6:56, Moon forms a quincunx with Libra Sun, and that could mean a desperate, but eloquent plea for reason. We close with the 7:54 shift of Mars into Cancer--not exactly a place where Mars is happy and that could leave him grumpy and sniping because he's forced to hide and stay put. Some of us may appreciate that quelling of Ram determination.

Saturday the 29th launches with the 8:40 a.m. EDT, Taurus Moon quincunx with Jupiter (in Sagittarius) bringing Earth and Fire energy together in a forced meeting. Could be difficult news environmentally--but success for some wanting to regain stability in some arena. Let's focus on the latter. At 11:46, Moon forms a sextile with Uranus (in Pisces), so now it's an Earth-Water dance, but more subtle, like a soft shower ruining a hostess' hair at a garden party. The final aspect of the day is the 5:32 p.m. EDT square between Moon and Neptune (still in Aquarius) and this is the most helpful because while old Bull gets a bum rap for being unyielding, after all of the radical behavior this summer, it's probably healthy for rejecting political spin and the over-gilding of a lily made of tin.

Sunday, the 30th and we say goodbye to September 2007 with a Taurus Moon-Venus (in Leo) square at 1:10 a.m. EDT meaning that sense and sensibility is suffering again/still in some relationships or arenas. Thus, the 4:45 a.m. Moon quincunx with Pluto (in Sagittarius) should give warning to those in domestic crises. At 10:34, Moon shifts to Gemini, and at 3:34 p.m.--once Gemini has its rocket launchers in its mouth--Moon forms a quincunx with Mercury in Scorpio. Not the most brilliant strategy for lasting friendships and universal peace. At 4:10 Moon squares with Saturn (in Virgo), which could be a military strike after such warm rhetoric. We close with a Moon-Libra Sun trine at 11:01--a last moment race of diplomats chasing to avert WWII? This suggests political behavior

like Venezuela's Chavez, or Iran's Ahmadinejad--in one moment cajoling and disdainful, in the next playing to the audience or selling another bill of goods to the UN. In any case, find something better to do with your time.
